12-07-83 Robert Lewis Flick who is presently an inmate in the Manitowoc County Jail request to see Det. Conrad. Det. Conrad then spoke with Mr. Flick on the second floor of the Sheriff's Dept. Mr. Flick stated that he has information that approximately 3½ to 5 years ago (however he wasn't sure of the time period) Gregory Allen was involved in a homicide somewhere in North Carolina. Flick stated that Gregory Allen personally told him (Flick) that he killed someone because he figured the individual was either a narcotic officer or a drug informant which he referred to as "Rat". The MO of the homicide was not known by Robert Flick. Flick also stated that Gregory Allen had an accomplice with him who is also involved in the homicide however that individuals name wasnot known. This unknown individual should have also been arrested along with Robert Flick on narcotic violations in the State of North Carolina. Allen and the unknown named accomplice both were convicted of narcotic violation and did serve time in prison together. Flick stated that Gregory Allen and the other unnamed individual were questioned regarding this homicide but couldnot be charged due to insufficient evidence. Flick also stated that [REDACTED] who is Gregory Allen's live in girlfriend also has information relating to this homicide. Flick also stated that Gregory Allen informed him of the above homicide during 1983 but he could not remember the exact date other than it was summer. Flick also stated that Gregory Allen supposedly has been convicted of violent crimes in other states but wasnot aware of those crimes.

Contact was then made with Assistant Supervisor Joe Hines of the North Carolina Department of Justice, Narcotics Enforcement Unit at Raleigh, North Carolina, at phone (919)779-1400. The information was related to Agent Hines that either a narcotics officer or narcotics informant was a victim of a homicide by Gregory Allen. Agent Hines will reseach their files and try and determine if a homicide did take place and if their agency was involved in the investigation or if a police department or Sheriff's Dept. handled the matter.

12-15-83 Agent Hines telephonically contacted Det. Conrad and stated that upon researching their intelligence files they have determined that on April 24, 1976, Gregory A. Allen was arrested in Boaufort County by the Boaufort County Sheriff's Dept. on a narcotics violation. Their records also indicate that on 10-28-76 Gregory A. Allen was sentenced to 24 months with the North Carolina Dept. of Corrections. Agent Hines also stated that their files indicate Gregory Allen has been arrested in Saint Cloud, Minnesota, and West Minster, California, for armed robbery, assault with a deadly weapon where a baseball bat was used to beat the store owner after committing an armed robbery. The incident in West Minster, California, took place March 30, 1970, with the case #CR513443 involving Greezy's Sporting Goods Store.

Agent Hines then provided Det. Conrad with the Boaufort County Sheriff's Dept. indicating that the Sheriff Nelson L. Shepard and the Sheriff's Dept. phone number is (919)946-7111. Agent Hines stated that if additional followup is needed by his agency we should contact him.

12-15-83 @ 1340 hrs. Det. Conrad telephonically contacted Boaufort County Sheriff Nelson L. Shepard. The information on the above matter was relayed to Sheriff Shepard and he will research his files and contact this agency if they do infact have an unsolved homicide.

12-15-83 @ 1400 hrs. Det. Conrad received a telephone call from Sheriff Shepard of the Beaufort County Sheriff's Dept. Sheriff Shepard stated that he has researched his files and came up with no unsolved homicides or any contact with Gregory Allen. Sheriff Shepard did state that possibly the incident took place in the community of Beaufort which is located in Carteret County in North Carolina.

12-15-83 @ 1430 hrs. Telephonic contact was established with the Carteret County Sheriff's Dept. (919)728-3772. Det. Conrad spoke with the Chief Deputy Joe Smith. The facts relating to this investigation were relayed to Chief Deputy Smith and he distinctly recalled a homicide incident where a sixteen year old girl was strangled and Gregory Allen was the main suspect but due to difficulties they were unable to charge him. Chief Deputy Smith stated that the investigation was actually handled by the Beaufort Police Dept. but his agency did assist. The chief deputy will contact the Beaufort Police Dept. and have one of his investigators contact this agency for further information. Chief Deputy Smith stated that he personally has arrested Gregory Allen on several sexual deviant crimes whereby Gregory Allen will masturbate in front of small children. The chief deputy also stated that he knows that Gregory Allen has a history of violent crimes but didnot have his record immediately available. Chief Deputy Smith will have one of his investigators contact this agency for further information.

12-15-83 @ 1730 hrs. Det. Conrad received a phone call from Det. Frank Galizi of the Carteret Sheriff's Dept. The above information was explained to Det. Galizi. Det. Galizi will obtain the original investigative file from the Beaufort Police Dept. and contact this agency on 12-16-83 to determine what further investigation will be necessary. Det. Galizi stated that they felt with the possible information of additional witnesses they would be able to put together enough information ^{OR} Gregory Allen.

12-16-83 @ 1500 hrs. Det. Conrad received a telephone call from Chief Charles Thompson of the New Port, North Carolina Police Dept. who's phone number is area code 919-223-5111 New Port, North Carolina is the jurisdiction where the 15 year old female, [REDACTED] was murdered. Chief Thompson was very familiar with this investigation and stated that the homicide took place 06-16-75 and that the female was found on 06-17-75. The fifteen year old victim had been strangled to death by an unknown assailant. [REDACTED] was known to associate with people who used drugs and was suspected that she herself smoked marijuana. Gregory Allen was in the area where the incident took place the night before the body was found and also returned to the same area the following day.

It was suggested that Chief Thompson forward his entire case file along with any crime scene photos to Det. Conrad that the case could be reviewed to provide a better understanding prior to any interriogation of Gregory Allen. Chief Thompson will forward the entire investigative file and that file should be at the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Dept. during the week of Dec. 19 to the 23rd.
