[redacted] stated [redacted] was on [redacted] bike, on [redacted] way to school about 0715 hrs. [redacted] stated [redacted] was riding down Park Road (west) when [redacted] saw a suspicious looking guy walking alongside the road in an easterly direction. [redacted] states that [redacted] left home at approximately 7:10 AM on 12/17/82; [redacted] got to the area just south of the intersection of Park and Neshotah Roads on the East side of the road. [redacted] cleaned off the fence in this area and looked for footprints (but did not see any) before sitting down. [redacted] was there less than one minute when [redacted] heard footsteps among the trees. [redacted] states that a male subject came from [redacted] left side and to the rear. Subject was wearing an old tan jacket with a hood which was also tan. Subject was wearing old blue jeans. The subject had his penis in his hand and at this time, [redacted] turned away. Then, the subject said would you rather do it yourself? [redacted] did not say anything. The subject then said, if you just touch me, I won't come back anymore. At this time, the bus came and the subject started walking back into the woods toward the lake.

[redacted] said the subject held his hood over his face; [redacted] did see his nose. [redacted] said the subject was light complected, in his 30's and he has a "girly" voice. [redacted] said the subject got within an arm's length of [redacted] and the subject kept moving closer. The subject was on the other side of the fence at all times.

[redacted] feels that if [redacted] saw this subject again [redacted] could recognize him if [redacted] saw his nose and heard his voice.

I (Detective Geigel) showed [redacted] pictures of [redacted] [redacted] said that [redacted] doesn't think it is the same person. [redacted] said [redacted] normally leaves the house at ten minutes after 7:00 AM and the bus gets to that location at 7:20 AM (0720 Hours). [redacted] also states that [redacted] will be going to school this coming Monday & Tuesday (12/20/82 & 12/21/82) at the same time and then [redacted] will have Christmas vacation. (It should be noted that I--Det. Geigel)--will do a stakeout there, myself, on Monday December 20, 1982, and on Tuesday, December

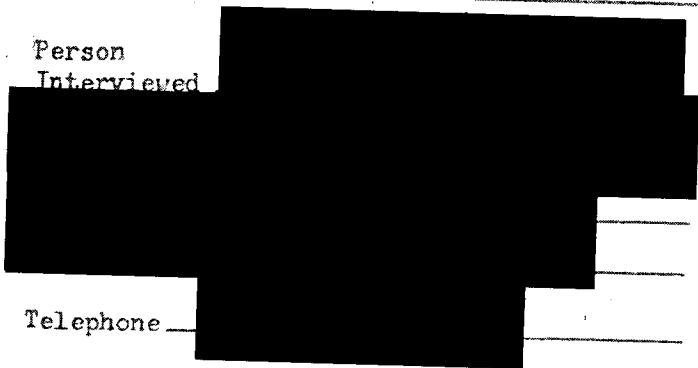

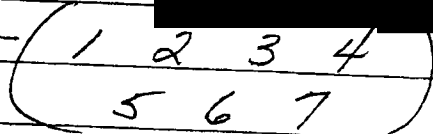
