10-26-86 @ 1650 hrs.: Officer met with CHARLES E. AVERY at his residence at 12928 Avery Rd. Two Rivers. Mr. Avery told officer that sometime since Friday, 10/24/86, at 6PM, when he and his family left for a weekend trip to Michigan, his trailer home was entered. Entry appeared to be made at the rear door of the trailer, but no forced entry could be observed. Once inside the trailer, the culprit(s) stole two shotguns, one 44 cal. rifle & \$10 worth of quarters. Form #023 was filled out and is attached to this complaint. Mr. Avery does not have the serial numbers on any of the firearms, nor does he know the manufacturer brand name of the rifle. Missing are the .44 cal. rifle, one Browning 12 ga. shotgun, one Remington 12 ga. 870 shotgun. Total value of the three weapons is approx. \$400.00. Several clothes cabinets & closets had been gone through in an apparent attempt to find other items of value. A security box full of insurance and other important papers was opened and left on the bedroom floor.

The complainant will phone our dept. on Monday to speak to a detective about possible attempts to gather fingerprints. Complainant has no idea how the trailer could have been entered without forced entry, except that he may have left a residence key in an AMC stationwagon (Wis. RP FF3106), which was left parked outside the house trailer. Nothing further to go on at this time. G.Dufek/ dmm

10-27-86: Went to the Avery trailer and dusted the gun cabinet, a tackle box and a compass. All items would have been in the area of where the theft occurred. No prints could be brought up as everything was quite smudgy. There were several old prints made from the children, (Avery's). No forced entry to the trailer as it appears the keys that were left in the AMC vehicle outside may have been the way the subject entered. I spoke with Al Avery, Charles father, and he stated he may have some numbers somewhere as the one shotgun that was taken was previously owned by Al. He will call in if he finds any of the numbers.
