44. DETAILED REPORT

09-25-88 @ approx. 1530 hrs.: Officer Anderson arrived again at the AVERY residence and met with [REDACTED] & [REDACTED]. The officer first spoke with [REDACTED] who stated he had intended to purchase a car from [REDACTED]. He stated EARL AVERY & his brother, CHUCK, had gotten into an argument as to who owned the vehicle, to sell it. [REDACTED] stated the first argument occurred inside the Avery (parents') residence, and [REDACTED] was not in the house at that time. After that, [REDACTED] accompanied EARL AVERY in the wrecker and they pulled up to the driveway at the CHUCK AVERY residence, where they began hooking up the disputed car. CHUCK AVERY came out of the house, yelling that they should both leave. [REDACTED] stayed in the wrecker or off the property and let the two brothers argue it out. The Averys began fighting and eventually were rolling around on the ground with each other. [REDACTED] stated he was on the other side of the wrecker & really didn't see much of the fight or how it started.

JUVENILE INFO REDACTED

Officer Anderson then interviewed [REDACTED] & inquired what had happened. [REDACTED] stated there was a dispute between himself & his brother, CHUCK, as to who purchased the vehicle and who could sell it. [REDACTED] confronted CHUCK at his parents' residence & demanded the keys to the vehicle, which Chuck refused to give him. They then began arguing and eventually [REDACTED] pushed CHUCK while in the house. [REDACTED] then left the residence & took the wrecker to tow the vehicle away, which was currently sitting in Chuck's driveway. [REDACTED] stated that CHUCK came out of the house, yelling that he should leave the car alone & get off the property. They argued at the front of the residence, and CHUCK pushed [REDACTED] then pushed CHUCK back. CHUCK went to the garage, picked up a shovel and threw it at [REDACTED]. The shovel hit the wrecker, and the two began to fight. CHUCK picked up the shovel & struck [REDACTED] in the chest area. [REDACTED] then stated he was struck somewhere near the head with the shovel. [REDACTED] managed to get the shovel away from CHUCK, and they wrestled on the ground. [REDACTED] stated he didn't know where the blood on CHUCK's nose occurred.

Officer then interviewed CHARLES (CHUCK) AVERY, as Chuck had made no mention of striking his brother with the shovel. CHUCK stated he did throw the shovel at his brother, but

missed him. CHUCK did not recall striking EARL on the head or across his chest with the shovel.

██████████ was taken into custody for DC, violation of State Law. ██████████ admitted that a disturbance did occur and that children were screaming. He stated Chuck's wife were screaming. Two people were wrestling upon the ground and both were injured, and ██████████ admitted being in an area where he did not belong (his brother's property). ██████████ was transported to MTSO Jail & allowed to make calls to arrange for bail.

Data Sheet was completed by Officer Bushman for the DC charge.

This report should be reviewed, along with the Statements, to see if Battery charges should be instituted against ██████████. Consideration should also be given to DC or Battery charges against CHARLES (CHUCK) AVERY, as to whether striking ██████████ would be a legitimate use of force to stop a Trespass on his land. Photos were taken & are attached of ██████████'s chest area, where marks from the shovel appear. MDAnderson/MA dmm

09-25-88 @ 1342 hrs.: Officer L.Bushman & M.Anderson arrived at 12930 Avery Rd. and were met by CHARLES & DONNA AVERY. CHARLES stated they had purchased a '77 Pontiac Catalina 4-Dr. (dk.brown) on this date in the AM and the vehicle had been parked at their residence. He stated the veh. had been purchased for use in the Avery Auto Salvage yard. Pontiac's VIN is 2L69R3P351924. CHARLES & DONNA stated they did go to Chuck's parents' residence, the Auto Salvage Yard, and were having coffee there when ██████████ came in & asked Chuck for the keys to the Pontiac. CHUCK told ██████████ he couldn't have the keys and would have to wait until their father got home to sell the vehicle. ██████████ became upset at this and placed CHARLES up against the wall in a forceful manner & spilled coffee down his (Charles) leg & lap area. ██████████ stated again that he wanted the keys, then turned & left the residence. He stated he would hook the vehicle onto the wrecker & take it. CHARLES & DONNA both left the residence, going back to their own residence. CHARLES stated he placed the pickup truck to the rear of the Pontiac. At that point ██████████ pulled up with the wrecker, and Chuck told him to leave the property. ██████████ refused and began to hook the wrecker onto the Pontiac. CHARLES was standing between the wrecker & the Pontiac, so ██████████ could not complete the hook-up. ██████████ became very upset & struck CHARLES in the face with his closed fist. He struck the left side bridge of Chuck's nose. At that time Chuck's glasses came off, and he sustained a swollen top & bottom lip w/laceration to the inside of his bottom lip.

CHARLES AVERY then retrieved his glasses and told ██████████ he was going to call the police. ██████████ pulled the vehicle from the yard with the wrecker, scraping the back portion of Chuck's Chevy pickup w/RP 71193. Damage to the pickup was extremely minimal, consisting of a scrape to the bumper.

It appears ██████████ pulled the vehicle behind the Avery Auto Salvage bldg., exited the wrecker and entered the salvage yard. Upon officers' arrival, they were unable to locate EARL in the salvage yard.

Statement Forms were completed by DONNA & CHARLES AVERY. Form #023 was completed by CHARLES AVERY, due to the fact ██████████ did not have permission to remove the vehicle or come onto the property to strike & injure Charles in any manner. Arrest Data Sheets were completed for DC & Battery and are attached.

Officer Anderson rec'd call via radio, advising that ██████████ had called MTSO & was willing to speak with Officer Anderson. Officer Anderson arrived at the AVERY residence & spoke w/EARL ref. this matter. L.Bushman/10/05

10-08-88: Responded to the Charles Avery residence and received a verbal statement from [REDACTED]. At this time we put [REDACTED] in the squad with her Mother Linda. We then waited for Charles to come in from the salvage yard and he wanted to know what we wanted. We advised him about an incident that had occurred this date and gave Charles his Miranda Rights. At this time we told him that we would be transporting him to the Sheriff Dept for statements and to get his side of the story. Also [REDACTED] was transported to the Sheriff Dept along with her Mother Linda. Also Mary Ann Peaslee from the DSS Dept was waiting for us when we arrived. [REDACTED] then wrote out a detailed statement as to what transpired the morning of 10-08-88. Charles E Avery charged with 940.225 (3) 3RD degree sexual assault, Data sheets made out, awaiting disposition. R Meihnsner from

10-08-88: Delivered AVERY, Charles E. to the jail section. After booking subject was interviewed after his Miranda was given again. He stated that he understood his "rights" and signed the waiver. The incident was discussed and he denied having anything to do with his daughter as was stated by her. He stated that he got up after his wife had gone to work in Mishicot. He stated that this was around 8-8:15 am. He then went to the kids room where [REDACTED] was also sleeping and got her up. He got her up by calling to her to get up. He stated that he did not touch her at all. He then went out to the shop to do some work. Later (around 9:30 am) he returned to check on the kids. At this time they were all up but in their P.J.s. He again returned to the shop. Around 11:30 am he went back to the house and they were all there and were dressed. Mr. Avery was asked why [REDACTED] would make up a story like this and he stated he did not know why. He remarked "why would I want to do a thing like that

when we are trying to adopt a baby? This was discussed further but nothing came up indicating that [REDACTED] would do this for spite etc. Subject was incarcerated and told he would most likely be charged with 940.225 (3) 3RD degree sexual assault.

Upon checking with Mary Peaslee and det. Meihnsner it was found that [REDACTED] was apparently touched at the age of 5 years. He mother had also mentioned that occurrence. [REDACTED] was asked if she had been touched at any other time in her life since the age of 5 up to this incident.? She stated "no that she had not."

Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] want to be notified prior to Charles release because they both feared for their safety. They were both advised that the recommendation was that he be released under no circumstances until court time. They were advised (and the jail was informed) if in the event he was released they would be for-warned by the jail. Det. ARK *ARK*

10-08-88: [REDACTED] called back from her residence in Manitowoc stating that she forgot to put the time this incident occurred on her statement. The incident would have occurred between 0600 Hrs and 0800 Hrs, and all the other children in the Charles Avery residence were sleeping at the time. R Meihnsner *len*

10-14-88: Information received was that [REDACTED] was taken to Holy Family Hospital regarding internal bleeding from the vaginal area. Apparently surgery was needed. Det. Jadowski did contact the hospital and did receive a statement from a Debra Wolak indicating that [REDACTED] was there for vaginal bleeding and a lacerations in the vaginal area. ARK. *ARK*

10-17-88: Contacted Al Gajewski regarding this info at DSS. He advised me that they had the info on this and that they will seek the medical report from the hospital and Doctor. Linda Schroeder is the assigned worker on this case. ARK *ARK*

10-17-88: Received the medical report and Linda schroeder did re-contact the victim inquiring if the victim had any contact with anyone else (sexually) during the time her father abused her and the time she went into the hospital [REDACTED] informed her that she had spent most of the time with her grandparent-s and did not have any contact with anyone else. Information was passed on to D.A. Carter along with the medical report prior to mr. Avery's initial hearing at 1500 hrs this date. A question of raising the degree from 3rd to 2nd degree was at question here. Det. ARK *ARK*

A meeting with this subject will be set up at Lincoln HS sometime in the afternoon this date. 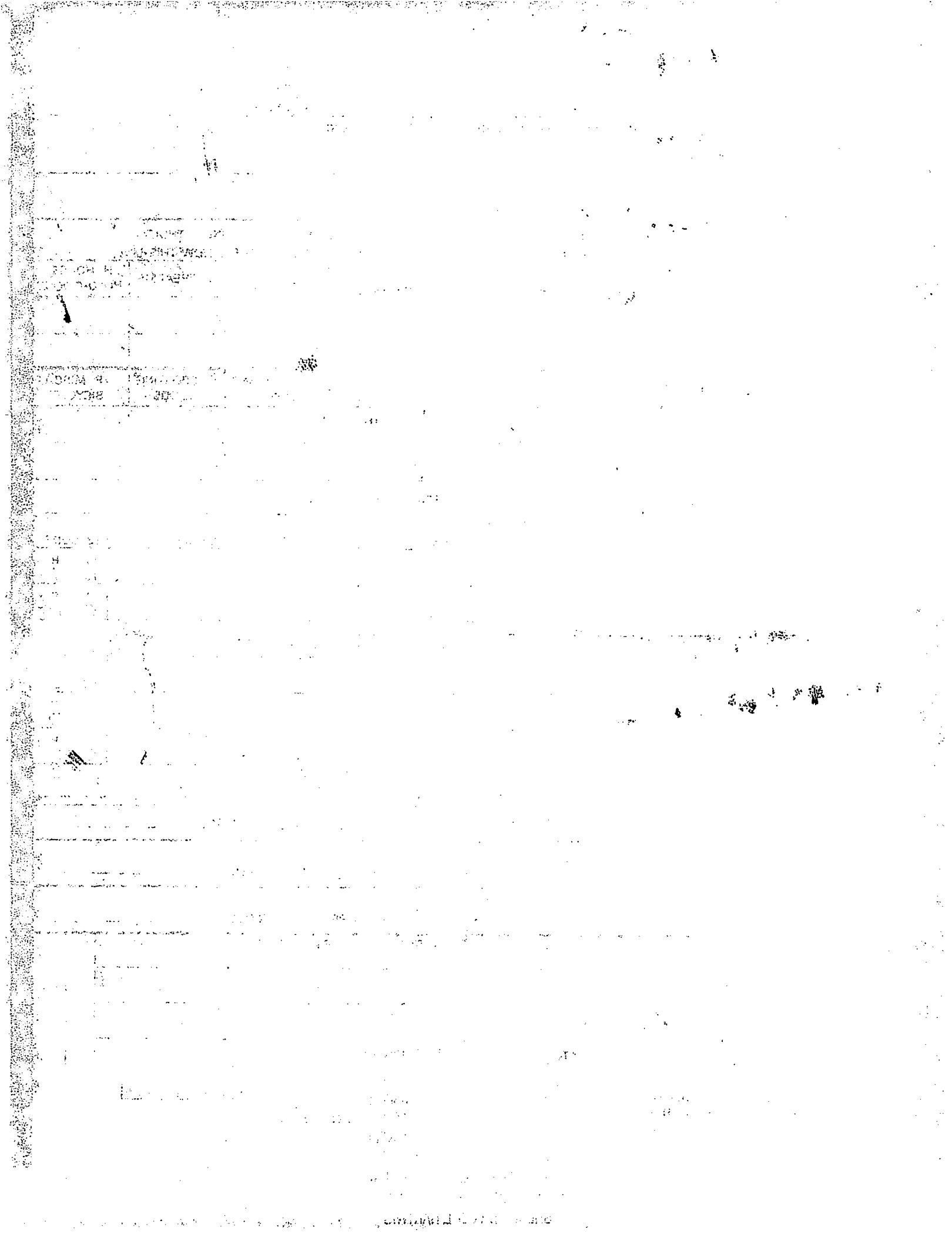
