SIGNATURE

The Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory in Madison received the following evidence on November 21, 2005:

Item DD: One sealed box containing one 22LR Marlin Glenfield 60 rifle, serial number 27323959, manufactured with sixteen lands and grooves with a right hand twist

The Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory in Madison received the following evidence on March 16, 2006:

Item FK: One sealed paper bag containing on 0.22-inch caliber bullet (Wt: 30.7 grains) exhibiting eight remaining of sixteen original land/groove impressions with a right hand twist

Item FL: One sealed paper bag containing one 0.22-inch caliber bullet (Wt: 19.7 grains) exhibiting eleven remaining of sixteen original land/groove impressions with a right hand twist

FINDINGS

1. The bullet in Item FL was fired from the Marlin rifle in Item DD. The bullet in Item FK exhibits the same physical class characteristics as the rifle in Item DD and could have been fired from that gun or any other with the same class characteristics.
