ORDER REGULATING CONDUCT OF WITNESSES DURING TRIAL

Pursuant to Wis. Stats. §906.15 and the stipulation of the parties dated December 13, 2006, the Court hereby orders that except as provided in paragraph 5, all persons who have been identified as potential witnesses by either party shall be subject to the following restrictions:

1. All listed potential witnesses shall be excluded from the courtroom during jury selection, opening statements and the testimony of all other witnesses.
2. All listed potential witnesses are prohibited from speaking to any other listed potential witness about any aspect of the case until the evidentiary portion of the trial has been completed.
3. All listed potential witnesses are prohibited from watching, listening to, or reading any news accounts concerning the trial, whether on television, radio, in newspapers, on the internet or from any other source, from the beginning of the trial until the evidentiary portion of the trial has been completed.


4. Notwithstanding the restrictions in paragraphs 1 through 3, listed potential witnesses are not prohibited from speaking or otherwise communicating with any attorney for either party.

5. The restriction in paragraph 1 shall not apply to Investigators Mark Wiegert, Special Agent Tom Fassbender, Conrad O. Baetz, or any member of the family of the victim, Teresa Halbach. The restriction in paragraph 2 shall not prohibit members of Teresa Halbach's family from speaking to each other during the trial. The restriction in paragraph 3 shall not apply to any member of the family of Teresa Halbach. None of the restrictions herein are applicable to the defendant, Steven Avery or to any members of the news media.

6. The attorneys for each party shall be responsible for notifying all of their potential witnesses of these restrictions.
