## Dear Judge Sutkiewicz:

As you are aware, the court appointed me (as well as prior counsel) as Mr. Avery's attorney in light of the State's concession that Mr. Avery's "recorded conversations" claim in his pm se Wis. Stat. § 974.06 motion would "require additional factual development before the court can rule." (May 13, 2013 Fallon letter, p. 3.)

I write to report that after extensive communications with trial counsel, having an investigator interview jail officials, and reviewing transcripts of the 6-week trial, hundreds (if not thousands) of pages of investigative reports, and other discovery, I have not located any additional facts that would support the "recorded conversations" claim.

Accordingly, I request that the court withdraw my appearance as Mr. Avery's counsel. I also suggest that the court schedule a status conference with Attorney Fallon and Mr. Avery to determine the next steps with respect to Mr. Avery's § 974.06 motion.
