09-20-84 - Subject called stating that they are having problems with Steven Avery in the neighborhood. He is exposing himself to a female that has to use the road. He will run out to the road side in the early morning hours when she drives past, and he will either expose himself to her, or he will run out to the edge of the road in the nude. He has been known to masturbate on the hood of the car as she is driving past. He has had sexual relations with his wife out on the lawn, while all the neighbors are home in the day time, and able to watch. We would like to have him stopped, especially the exposing of himself. The exposing will usually take place at 5:30 A.M. He has field glasses on the house and he knows just when she will be driving past the residence. At this point he will then run out to the road and do his tricks. This has been taking place for the past several months. The female in question that he is exposing himself to is Mrs. William Morris. She is scared for her safety at the present time, but I feel that perhaps if Bill Morris were spoken to, he would confirm this report, as he has hidden in the car at one time, in an attempt to catch him. 09-23-84 @ 1100 hrs: Made contact with the witness, Mrs. William Morris (Sandra L.), dob 05-24-51, Rt. 1, Box 234, Whitelaw, WI, telephone 755-4659. The home is located first house south of the Melnick Lutheran Church in Melnick. Mrs. Morris was reluctant to give a statement of the incident involving Mr. Avery but did indicate that Mr. Avery has exposed himself on numerous occasions approximately 5:30 a.m. to her as she drives to work. She further indicated she is a second cousin to Steven Avery and this is one reason why she is reluctant to give a statement. Rather than give a statement she indicated she would like an officer to ride with her at the time she goes past the Avery residence and at the time Mr. Avery exposes himself she would stop and the officer could make the arrest. She stated that the father of Steven Avery, Mr. Alan Avery, runs the Avery Junk Yard was notified of Steven's activity last week and she feels that maybe the problem is resolved through his dad. This usually occurs on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday morning when she goes to work. If Mr. Avery exposes himself on Monday, the 24th, she will notify the department and arrangements will have to be made through Capt. Belz for an officer to be assigned to ride with her on Tuesday or Wednesday of this coming week. It is also suggested that the officer take along a camera. If this incident occurs, a picture can be taken of Mr. Avery exposing himself. Apparently he runs right up to the roadway naked at the time Mrs. Morris travels east past the Avery residence. A statement form was left with Mrs. Morris that if this incident occurs that we would like a statement from her regarding the past incidents. Complaint is still under investigation awaiting assignment from Capt. Belz for an officer to ride with Mrs. Morris at the time she goes past the Avery residence. Det. L.Jadowski *LJB* dk

Mr Morris told me that Steve Avery jumped into the middle of the road without clothing on Tue morning about 0545 11-27-84 and she almost hit him, as it was raining out at the time and she had her windshield wipers on at the time. The Det's would be at the Morris residence on 12-03-84 by 0545 Hrs, and if they are not at the residence she should leave without them. This also would be depending on the weather of course. 12-03-84: Mrs Morris was met at her residence with Det Jadowski riding with her. No confrontation with Mr Avery occurred. Det Jadowski picked up at the intersection of CTH Y and CTH Q. One more attempt to be made on 12-04-84. R Meihnsner. *Rcm*.

12-04-84: Met with Mrs Morris with Det Jadowski again riding with her. No confrontation with Avery. No further meets will be set up until the weather warms up or if Mr Avery again starts his routine. R Meihnsner *Rcm*
