Upon reading a statement made out by Mrs. Wayne Marcelle of CTH Y and RR, Maribel, Wisconsin, statement was in reference to the arrest of Steven Avery on 07-29-85 Statement was originally obtained to ascertain if there was any activity in the Avery yard shortly after the incident took place. Part of her statement is as follows:

I don't know if this is relevent, but during Memorial Day weekend, there was an eleven year old girl abducted in Marinette County. My mother-in-law, Mrs. Amanda Marcelle of Manitowoc, phone was fishing in the High Falls flowage area of Marinette County during the Memorial Day weekend and identified Steve Avery fishing in the area. She also saw a brown van. The fact that she saw Avery and the brown van has been bothering her ever since she saw the brown van in his yard several weeks ago.

The information and statement was passed onto Chief Deputy R. Kohlman of Marinette County Sheriff's Dept. Chief Deputy Kohlman did verify the fact that the abduction and sexual assault of the eleven year old girl did infact take place a short distance from where Avery had been seen, infact the Chief Deputy believes that Steven Avery's father has a cottage in that same area. Chief Deputy Kohlman stated he was very much interested in the facts and would be proceeding to Manitowoc County possibly to interview Steve on 07-31-85.

07-31-85 @ 1100 hrs. Chief Deputy Kohlman appeared at this office, a copy of the statement from Mrs. Wayne Marcelle was given along with a recent photograph of suspect, Steve Avery. Chief Deputy Kohlman gave this department a special bulletin reference to the abduction and sexual assault dated 28 May, 1985, for our files. Due to the fact that orders have been passed by attorneys representing Mr. Avery that no law enforcement officers may speak to their client at this time, Chief Deputy Kohlman was told that we would do everything in our power to ascertain if Steve Avery, infact was the person involved in their case. Chief Deputy Kohlman will be calling back in a few days with possibly added information and/or any results we come up with. Statement from Mrs. Wayne Marcelle and a copy of the special bulletin are part of this file.

Rederence On Tuesday May 28, 1985 at approximately 10AM an 11 year old town of Stephenson girl who had missed the school bus and was walking to school, was abducted and sexually assaulted.

The girl was walking on Newton Lake Road near North Zak Lane in the Township of Stephenson approximately 7 miles north/west of Crivitz when an unknown male ran from the woods, grabbed complete her and pulled her into the woods where he made her lay face down, removed (pulled down) her jeans and underpants and began assaulting her with his finger. She screamed and he cupped his left hand over her mouth. She bit him between the left thumb and forefinger and he let her go. He removed her shoes, threw them into the brush and ran in a northwesterly direction back across Newton Lake Road.

> SUSPECT: W/M, 5-7, dark brown hair, heavy build with a "beer belly." When he grabbed the girl he was not wearing any clothing. He had a red and brown plaid flannel shirt tied around his head and wore ankle length moccasins on his feet.

Prior to the assault, a vehicle passed her three times while she was walking. Vehicle may have been driven by suspect.

VEHICLE: Brown pickup truck, make and license unknown, with one or more orange stripes on the bed.

When victim was first interviewed she described the NOTE: vehicle as looking something like a cut down van,

so we are presently looking 3for any pickup or cutdown type vehicle, brown with the orange stripe(s).
