On 11-05-05 at about 1337 hours I, Off. Stone was at the PD when I heard dispatch assign Sgt. Flemal and Off. Hyler to an EMS call at Ancient Rites, 1910 Franklin St., in which a woman had been struck in the head with an ax. I heard Sgt. Flemal radio that the suspect was last seen running EB on Franklin St. I left the PD and began responding to the area to search for the suspect, as did other Officers.

When I arrived in the area, Sgt. Flemal was requesting another Officer to assist him in clearing the residence of 1905 Franklin St., as the suspect might possibly be inside, and this would be the residence where the attack occurred. I met Sgt. Flemal at 1905 Franklin St. and we cleared the residence, locating nobody inside. Sgt. Flemal and I cleared the detached garage, and nobody was inside the garage either. As we were clearing the house and got to the kitchen area, I could see _____ and what appeared to be hair on the floor in front of the refrigerator. I could also see several _____ spots on the floor in front of the stove. Once the residence was secure, Off. Pusel and Off. Seidl had also arrived. Off. Pusel was advised to begin a log of everyone that entered/exited the building. Sgt. Flemal put yellow crime scene tape around the residence.

Off. Hyler come over by Sgt. Flemal and I at 1905 Franklin St. He had been at Ancient Rites and advised me the victim would be CHARLENE EDWARDS, and advised she had been struck with a hatchet in the head, and had a _____ on the _____ of her area. CHARLENE was transported via Rescue Squad to Holy Family Memorial Medical Center. Off. Hyler checked the backyard and located a hatchet in the grass behind the house at 1905 Franklin St., and he pointed it out to me. The hatchet would be 14 ½" long, with a brown and red wood handle. The head of the hatchet would be blue, and would be 5 ½" long and 3 ¼" at the widest point (sharpened end).

I learned Off. Seidl was speaking with CHARLENE'S _____, and I went and spoke with CHARLENE'S _____, who was in front of _____ house. _____ said _____ had been with _____ cousin, and _____ got dropped of at _____ house at _____. Shortly after _____ got home, ANDRES MARTINEZ came to the house and let himself inside. _____ said ANDRES has a key to the house. From past contact with CHARLENE and ANDRES I knew they had resided together. _____ told me ANDRES and CHARLENE have been living together off and on for the past three years. _____ went on to say that ANDRES had come to the house to write a note for CHARLENE. _____ said _____ had gone to pick up CHARLENE from work and they came home around 1:30 or 1:45 pm. JOSHUA was sitting in the kitchen, and ANDRES was in the kitchen with him when CHARLENE and _____ came home. He said CHARLENE walked into the kitchen and she saw ANDRES and told him she didn't want to see him anymore. _____ said CHARLENE told ANDRES she was seeing someone else and ANDRES called her a "dirty fucking bitch". _____ told me CHARLENE and ANDRES began arguing about the above listed Chevrolet Cavalier, as ANDRES says the car is his because he bought it, but the car is titled under CHARLENE'S name. ANDRES was asking CHARLENE for the title saying the car was his, but CHARLENE refused to give the title to him. _____ said ANDRES became very upset with CHARLENE and began yelling at her that "you can die you fucking bitch", saying the next time he came over he would smash out all the windows on the house, said he'd burn down the house with the kids in it and told her "I hope you burn in hell".

_____ said ANDRES grabbed CHARLENE with both hands by the upper arm/shoulder area and threw her down to the floor, and CHARLENE landed on her back. She then rolled over

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onto her stomach and CHARLENE began calling _____ for help. _____ would have been in the living room when this occurred. Upon seeing this, _____ ran at ANDRES to him to get him away from CHARLENE. _____ said ANDRES moved and pushed _____ causing _____ to fall on his back on the floor. _____ had come into the kitchen and tried pulling CHARLENE across the floor to get her out of the room, and ANDRES pushed _____ shoulder and this knocked _____ to the floor.

_____ said ANDRES went into a pantry that would be off the kitchen by the stove, and when he came back into the kitchen, he had a hatchet in his hand. He said the hatchet had red on the handle, and could not describe it further. _____ said _____ began cursing at ANDRES, calling him a "mother-fucker." _____ said ANDRES grabbed CHARLENE'S left leg, while she was still lying on her stomach, and said "die dirty bitch" as he (ANDRES) brought the hatchet up in his right hand about to his head height, and struck CHARLENE with the hatchet in the _____ of her _____ of her _____ immediately saw "a _____ and _____ and saw CHARLENE put her hand to the _____ of her _____ and then CHARLENE rolled onto her back. He said CHARLENE began saying, "I'm sorry, I'm sorry, leave me alone" and put her hands up as if to protect herself. _____ told me that after hitting CHARLENE, _____ was about four feet from ANDRES calling him a "mother-fucker" and telling ANDRES he had no right to do this to _____ mother and saying "you don't give a fuck about her". _____ said ANDRES swung the hatchet at _____ missing _____ left arm by about two inches. _____ showed me how much the hatchet missed _____ by holding _____ index and thumb apart about two inches. _____ said ANDRES moved the hatchet to his left hand and brought it way behind his head, near his back, and brought the hatchet down as fast as he could and hit CHARLENE again. _____ was not sure if this swing struck CHARLENE or not.

_____ said _____ and _____ were trying to help CHARLENE when a pitbull (listed above), owned by HUE LEE, came into the kitchen. _____ said the pitbull began going after ANDRES as if he was trying to defend CHARLENE, and ANDRES swung the hatchet at the pitbull, striking it in the head. When ANDRES was distracted by the pitbull, CHARLENE was able to get up on her feet, and she ran out the back door. ANDRES ran out the back door chasing CHARLENE, and _____ went out behind ANDRES. _____ saw CHARLENE running down the driveway (NB), and _____ heard ANDRES say, "See you later", then saw ANDRES run into the backyard, drop the hatchet and jump over a fence into the yard of 1901 Franklin St. and run EB.

ANDRES was last seen wearing a sleeveless green/yellow packer shirt, blue jeans, black boots, black sunglasses and a white baseball style hat. He would be 5'05", 170 lbs, black hair and brown eyes.

_____ filled out a statement form, which I attached to this report.

Off. Seidl spoke with _____ and he obtained a Written Statement from _____ Please see Off. Seidl's addition for further information.

Sgt. Flemal advised he spoke with JOSEPH WOODSIDE and CLINT ANDREWS who were both at Ancient Rites when CHARLENE came inside. He had asked them to fill out statement forms, but they did not wish to do so at this time until ANDRES was arrested, as they feared ANDRES may come after them. I went to Ancient Rites and learned they had cleaned up the

from the floor of where CHARLENE had been. I was advised that the pitbull ran over to Ancient Rites and was put into the bathroom. I looked at the bathroom and noticed small amounts of [redacted] on the toilet, floor and garbage can. Off. Hyler took photographs of the bathroom. I also had Off. Hyler photograph the exterior of the residence 1905 Franklin St. along with the hatchet in the backyard. He took care of this while I was speaking with JOSHUA. Off. Hyler also photographed the injury to the pitbull. When he finished at Franklin St., I asked Off. Hyler to go to HFMMC and take photographs of CHARLENE'S injuries; and he photographed her injuries.

When I finished speaking with [redacted] I left the residence and went to HFMMC to speak with CHARLENE. When I arrived, I spoke with HFMMC personnel, who advised that the hospital was under a lock-down as they were concerned ANDRES may come to the hospital and attack CHARLENE again.

At HFMMC, Sgt. Waskow, Det. Trilling and Off. Hyler were there. Det. Trilling asked me to speak with CHARLENE and to audio record her interview, and advised he was going to the scene at 1905 Franklin St. When I went into the Emergency room CHARLENE was in, I noticed she was lying on her stomach on the hospital gurney. She had a large bandage to the [redacted] of her [redacted] and I saw [redacted] on her [redacted] and in her hair. I could see a small [redacted] hat was [redacted] to the [redacted] of her [redacted] that was [redacted] I asked CHARLENE if ANDRES still lives with her, and she advised he no longer lives with her and he has been out of the house for about a month and there is a Restraining Order against him.

In speaking with CHARLENE, she advised she got done with work at 0500 hours today and went to a friend's house (JASON ROSS) after work. She said ROSS is just a friend. CHARLENE went on to say she had called [redacted] to pick her up and bring her home; and [redacted] and HUE picked her up from ROSS'S house. She said when she got home and went in the kitchen ANDRES was there and told her not to be mad and said he wanted to talk; and she told him to leave. She said it was [redacted] ANDRES and her in the kitchen. CHARLENE said ANDRES was mad because he knew she was at ROSS'S. When asked how he knew, CHARLENE said she told him. CHARLENE told ANDRES "I'm sorry ANDRES, but you have to leave" and he said he was not mad at her. CHARLENE told ANDRES she was leaving with the kids to get something to eat and ANDRES said, "okay". She said they all began to walk out the back door, when ANDRES hit her in the back of the [redacted] and she fell down on her back on the kitchen floor. CHARLENE said she never had an "ax" in the pantry; that it was always in the garage. CHARLENE said after being hit with the hatchet the first time, ANDRES said, "This is what you get". When asked if he said anything else to her, she said ANDRES said nothing more. ANDRES then struck CHARLENE three more times in the [redacted] while she was down on the floor. I asked if he struck her with the sharpened end or blunt end of the hatchet, and she did not know.

CHARLENE said [redacted] and [redacted] tried to stop him by grabbing the "ax", but were unsuccessful. She said the pitbull came into the kitchen and ANDRES hit the dog in the head with the "ax". I noticed a [redacted] on CHARLENE'S [redacted] that appeared to me to be a defensive wound and asked her about how she received the [redacted] She told me she was lying on her back on the kitchen floor and had her arms covering her head (her arms were actually touching her head) to try to stop the "ax". She believed the hatchet stuck her [redacted] at this time, which caused the [redacted]

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CHARLENE stated she blacked out a little while, and when she came to, the pitbull and her German Shepard were between ANDRES and her. She said _____ was fighting with ANDRES and yelling, "Run mom run". She got up off the floor and ran out the back door closest to the garage and ran to the tattoo parlor. I asked if ANDRES chased her out of the house, and she said he didn't. I asked CHARLENE why this happened, and she said it was because she doesn't want to be with him anymore. I asked why he did this to her, and CHARLENE said, "To kill me". CHARLENE told me when ANDRES was charged with Battery, that he told her he would kill her if she left him.

ANDRES was charged with Battery/DVO following an incident reported on 10-03-05, see report 2005-00011332. ANDRES would be out on bail, and a condition of bail is that he has no contact with CHARLENE. A copy of the bail conditions is attached to this report. I learned the Restraining Order CHARLENE referred to would actually be a court order not to contact her.

I further spoke with CHARLENE and asked if they have had contact with each other since ANDRES last left. She kicked ANDRES out of her house and he would be staying with CARLOS LOPEZ. She said he has stopped by her place of employment and she has gone to where he is staying at his request. She said they have met about 10 times since ANDRES was ordered to have no contact with her. I spoke with her about how he has treated her, and she said ANDRES is very nice to her, bringing her flowers and buying her a ring. She said during most of the times they meet, ANDRES has asked her to drop the Battery charges against him.

I asked CHARLENE if he has threatened her, and she said ANDRES has said he would kill her if she left him. I asked CHARLENE if she knew of anyone else that would have brought the hatchet inside the house, and she could not think of anyone else. She told me that on 10-03-05, the day ANDRES was arrested for Battery, that her brother, CRAIG FICKETT had put the hatchet inside the garage, but she has no idea who would have brought it into the house. CHARLENE last saw the hatchet in the garage about two weeks ago, but could not recall where in the garage it was.

When asked where she thought ANDRES might be now, she thought perhaps at CARLOS LOPEZ'S house at 3910 Waldo Blvd. or his ex-wife's (VERIAN MARTINEZ) house at 1026 So. 14 St. She said ANDRES is unemployed, has no family in the area, owns no cars, she could not think of any taverns he frequents or any friends he would go to. CHARLENE was being prepped to go into surgery to repair her wounds. Before she left, she was explained the Authorization to Release Medical Information form and she signed it. She also was explained the Statement of Non-Consent, and signed the form. A DVC card, Manitowoc County Victim Information form and the Crime Victim Compensation Program Application Information form were all explained to her and the forms were left with her property. She was not able to fill out a Statement form and was brought to _____ shortly afterward. Sgt. Waskow remained outside the surgical room during the surgery until she was advised to leave by Detectives.

I learned that CHARLENE received a _____ to the _____ of her _____ to the _____ of her _____ on the _____ to the _____ of her _____ and a _____ to her _____

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POLICE OFFICER

While at HFMMC, several family members came to be with CHARLENE. I had an opportunity to speak with [redacted] again and asked [redacted] if [redacted] knew how the hatchet got into the pantry. [redacted] said [redacted] last saw the hatchet in the garage on top of an old entertainment center. [redacted] told me [redacted] has brought over the hatchet and gave it to ANDRES to chop wood with back in September 2005. [redacted] said [redacted] was last in the garage about two weeks ago and [redacted] didn't see the hatchet then, but it might have been there and [redacted] may have just not seen it. [redacted] was last in the kitchen pantry on Monday, 10-31-05, and it was not in the pantry then.

[redacted] would be [redacted] years old and I had [redacted] sign a Statement of Non-Consent for ANDRES pushing [redacted] down and swinging the hatchet at [redacted] and gave [redacted] a copy of the Manitowoc County Victim Information form. [redacted] also told me [redacted] was with [redacted] cousin and came home on 11-04-05 at about 3:00 pm. When they went in the house, ANDRES was in CHARLENE'S bedroom. They were talking with ANDRES and during the conversation ANDRES said "If anyone messes with me, I'll slice 'em open with my ax". [redacted] cousin did not want name mentioned.

I next spoke with [redacted] and [redacted] is [redacted] years old. [redacted] told me briefly what [redacted] told to Off. Seidl. [redacted] said ANDRES had pushed [redacted] by the left shoulder, knocking [redacted] down to the kitchen floor. I had her sign a Statement of Non-Consent for ANDRES pushing [redacted] down and gave a copy of the Manitowoc County Victim Information form. I asked [redacted] about the hatchet and where [redacted] has seen it. [redacted] said ANDRES had a red, metal tool box out in the garage, and [redacted] has seen the hatchet in the toolbox. [redacted] never saw it in the kitchen pantry.

While at HFMMC, I was approached by CHARLENE'S sister, CHRISTINE FICKETT. CHRISTINE was concerned because she said ANDRES has threatened in the past that if CHARLENE leaves him, he will burn CHARLENE'S house, CRAIG FICKETT'S house at 618 N 6 St. and CHARLENE'S parent's, DONNA and HARRY FICKETT'S house at 1014 S 19 St. There were several Officers, Detectives and Sergeant's looking for ANDRES and this information was passed on to them.

I also spoke with CRAIG FICKETT at HFMMC. I asked him if he had put a hatchet in CHARLENE'S garage when ANDRES was arrested for Battery on 10-03-05, and he said he vaguely remembers that he may have done that. He said he is the owner of 1905 Franklin St. and CHARLENE rents from him. He was last in the garage on 11-02-05 and did not recall seeing the hatchet in the garage, but it may have been there and he just didn't notice it. He has not been in the kitchen pantry lately.

CARLA WAGNER, a sister of CHARLENE, was also at HFMMC and after she spoke with LAURA HENZE, the on-call worker for DHS, she took custody of CHARLENE'S children. HENZE was notified of this incident.

While I was in the Emergency room with CHARLENE, I asked what had been done with her clothing, and was advised by ER personnel it had been placed in two plastic bags after they cut the clothing off of her. I advised CHARLENE I was taking the clothing for evidentiary purposes. I placed the bags of clothing in the trunk of squad 53 and locked the trunk.

When complete at HFMMC, I returned to 1905 Franklin St. Off. Block was at the scene and I assisted him in photographing the exterior and interior of the residence, and also assisted him

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with evidence collection. Please see Off. Block's addition for further information. The scene was ultimately released to CRAIG FICKETT at 1912 hours. I drew a rough sketch of the kitchen and Off. Block drew a rough sketch of the backyard. These were attached to the report, as was the Crime Scene Entry Log filled out by Off. Pusel and the evidence collection log.

When complete at 1905 Franklin St., I brought CHARLENE'S clothing to the Police Department. I opened the bags and found some of the clothing was very wet and saturated with . I hung all of the clothing in the PD Drying Room. The clothing was tagged with evidence tag #30435. The Drying Room was secure, marked as a "bio-hazard" and evidence tape was placed across the door and doorframe. The clothing would be two white socks, two white tennis shoes, a pair of purple pants, two pieces of a white t-shirt, two pieces of a multi-colored shirt and a silver and purple hairclip with butterfly designs on it. The audiocassette of the interview with CHARLENE was tagged with evidence tag #30437 and placed with the evidence Off. Block collected.

I contacted DVC worker #152 and notified them of this incident. At this point we have not been able to locate ANDRES. ANDRES was charged with Attempted 1st Degree Homicide/DVO, 940.01(1); Intimidation of a Victim/DVO, 940.45(1); Endangering Safety By Use of a Dangerous Weapon, 941.20(1); Mistreating Animals, 951.02; two counts of Physical Abuse of a Child, 948.03(2)(b); and Bail Jumping, 946.49(1)(a); with the charges being referred to the DA's office.

Upon running a Probation/Parole check on ANDRES, it came back with a positive Probation/Parole response, and he would be on parole with DON STEPHANCIC. Sgt. Flenal spoke with STEPHANCIC and an Apprehension Request was later issued for ANDRES. Lt. Boldt had an ECAR message put out to attempt to locate ANDRES.

Please forward a copy of this report to Probation/Parole, DHS and the District Attorney's Office. No further follow-up at this time.

On 11-05-05, I, Off. Seidl received a call for assistance from Sgt. Flemal while on a Rescue Squad call at 1905 Franklin St., which may have been for a possible attempted homicide.

I arrived on the scene and found there were two locations involved 1905 Franklin St. and Ancient Rites Tattoo parlor. I called for barricades from DPW for better traffic control and to allow us control of the scene.

I was assigned to speak with [redacted] one of the [redacted] involved in the call. [redacted] stated that ANDRES MARTINEZ who is [redacted] mother's boyfriend was already at their house when [redacted] returned home from work with [redacted] mother shortly after 1:00 P.M. [redacted] mother CHARLENE EDWARDS, ANDRES and [redacted] were getting ready to leave through the backdoor when ANDRES grabbed something from the pantry. [redacted] stated [redacted] saw it was wood but did not know what it was and he started hitting [redacted] mother. [redacted] stated the first hit was very fast, he hit her again and [redacted] got between them and ANDRES pushed [redacted] off to which [redacted] thought was the right. ANDRES then hit [redacted] mother again and [redacted] stated [redacted] grabbed a wood window shutter and told him to get away from [redacted] and [redacted] told [redacted] to call 911. [redacted] stated [redacted] ran to a corner of the front door and was protecting [redacted] with [redacted] legs in the air because he was trying to grab [redacted] phone.

[redacted] was able to call 911, and as [redacted] was calling, [redacted] ran across the street to ANCIENT RITES. [redacted] stated [redacted] followed and when [redacted] got there [redacted] was laying on her face and at that point the Police showed up. I asked [redacted] if [redacted] knew where ANDRES went at this time and [redacted] stated [redacted] did not know what happened to him. [redacted] also told me as [redacted] was calling 911 [redacted] ran upstairs to the top of the steps to get [redacted] dog and bring it along with [redacted] to ANCIENT RITES. [redacted] also told me [redacted] mother's dog followed them over. I asked [redacted] at what point [redacted] ran up the stairs for the dog and [redacted] stated after ANDRES was trying to take away [redacted] phone. I asked [redacted] at what point he left alone and [redacted] stated ANDRES left [redacted] alone after he realized he was not able to take away [redacted] phone.

I asked if [redacted] saw what it was that he used to hit [redacted] mother and [redacted] replied no, but whatever it was should be in the kitchen. [redacted] told me ANDRES is [redacted] mother's boyfriend, and I asked [redacted] if they argued lately. [redacted] told me that [redacted] mom was gone all day yesterday and today when [redacted] got home [redacted] told him it was over and she didn't want to be with him. [redacted] also told me that yesterday he took [redacted] car while [redacted] was visiting a friend's house. ANDRES knew [redacted] was there and no key was required to start [redacted]

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the car. could only tell me this friend was first name JASON last name unknown with a phone number of 242-8233. While I was speaking with had mother's dog with and was making arrangements to have someone take care of this dog. While was on the phone I heard tell the person was speaking with that ANDRES made the comment he would burn the house down with them in it. I asked about that comment after the phone call and stated that he made that comment to mother the last time he hit her.

I also asked if ANDRES hit anyone else and stated that he did not hit , or brother, but he did hit dog, which is a beige pit bull, and the dog had a gash on its head. stated the dog was protecting mom and it came at him (ANDRES) but it did not bite him because ANDRES then hit the dog. I did not see that the dog and was taken care of by someone else. The dog with was a German Shepard, and I transported to a house on FRANKLIN St. but those people were not home. I then transported to grandparent's house at 1014 S. 19th St. and grandpa HARRY FICKETT agreed to take the dog. was then transported to HFMMC and turned over to ER personnel to be with mother. completed a Written Statement, which is attached.

On 11-05-05 at 1337 hrs. I, Sgt. Leist, heard the dispatch of a female hit with an ax in the 1900 blk. of Franklin St. I went westbound on Franklin responding to the call when I heard Sgt. Flemal state that the suspect, ANDRES MARTINEZ, ran eastbound on Washington St. I proceeded to Washington St. and there was no one in sight. I began checking the area including stopping in at the Marathon Station and Family video. Officer Dramm arrived in the area and we checked the bar at S 18th and Washington St, I believe the new name is Tropics. No one saw MARTINEZ.

Officer Dramm and I then went with Officer Trainor to 1026 S. 14th St. where VERIAN MARTINEZ lives. She agreed to let us check her apt. for ANDRES, however, after only checking a couple of rooms she said she wanted us to stop and leave. Officer Trainor stood by and officer Dramm and I checked Kenny B's Bar, Saucy's Bar, TJ'S Bar, and Glens Bar. No one at any of these establishments saw ANDRES MARTINEZ. While at Glen's Bar VERIAN MARTINEZ was there and she asked if we were going to sit outside her house all night. I told her we were concerned for her safety and we were watching her house as ANDRES has frequented there in the past. She said "If I let you check my house will you leave and not bother me anymore tonight. I said yes, if she lets us make a complete search. She asked for a ride back to her house and she then let Officer Trainor, Dramm, and I to check her house completely. ANDRES was not located.

I went with Officers Zimney and Garber, along with Officer Weyer on several other checks. See Zimney's addition for that information. I made one last check of 1014 S. 19th, CHARLENE EDWARDS' parents house and found that to be secure.

On 11-06-05 at 0935 hrs. Officers Dramm, Buck, and I went to 1711 Washington St. in an attempt to locate a lower apt. with TIFFANY CHIZEK. Our first attempt lead to no answer at either lower apt. We then went to 1026 S. 14th in an attempt to make contact with VERIAN MARTINEZ. There was no answer. We made contact with a renter from upstairs, I showed the picture of ANDRES and said comes around the lower apt. I asked if saw in the past 24 hrs, said no. I asked to call should show up. We tried again later and made contact at the rear lower apt. with SUSAN ANDERSON. She said she just moved in last week and she knows who ANDRES MARTINEZ is but has not seen him around here. I was called by the renter of the front lower apt. ANTREDIOUS JONES. He called me and asked why we were knocking on his apt. I explained that we were looking for ANDRES MARTINEZ and that there is a TIFFANY CHIZEK that lives with a friend of MARTINEZ, a male by the name of Reggie. JONES did not know any of those people, he said he moved in last week, he offered to come home and let us search the apt. We did wait and when he arrived we checked the apt. with nothing found. I showed JONES the picture of MARTINEZ and told him to call should MARTINEZ come around.

Officer Dramm and I checked 3910 Waldo #35 again with no answer. We showed the picture to neighbors and asked them to call if they see him. We also checked 3703 S. 10th St. again and spoke to JAMES NETTLES. He had not heard from ANDRES and said he would call. I asked if he thought ANDRES could be in the Milwaukee area. JAMES said its possible as ANDRES drove trucks out of Milwaukee after he was released from prison back in 2001. He had no specific names or addresses. We went back to 1026 S. 14th St. and made contact with VERIAN MARTINEZ. She was not happy to see us. I asked if she saw or heard from him, she said no. She said we are not searching her house again. I asked her if she was concerned for her safety, she said "no." I told her I was, and that was part of the reason we keep checking back with her. I then learned that TARA NOVAK is living at 910

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Huron St. I will be attempting contact with her as time permits. She may be in a _____ at this time.

On 11-05-05 at 1411 hours, I Sgt. Zimney was requested by Lt. Boldt to report for duty due to the attempted homicide incident. At 1445 hours, Lt. Boldt assigned officer Garber and I to try and locate the suspect, MARTINEZ. Sgt. Leist and officer Weyer were also assigned to search for the suspect. Sgt. Leist had received information that MARTINEZ'S current girlfriend was TARA NOVAK. Officer Garber and I assisted Sgt. Leist in going to 3315 Yorkshire Lane #16, to check for MARTINEZ. The renter there told Sgt. Leist that she had just recently moved in but she did believe the former renter was a person named TARA.

I then suggested that we check the residence of CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNE HARRISON, as I knew MARTINEZ stayed at that residence. We arrived to the residence located at 3910 Waldo Blvd., trailer # 35 and Officers Leist and Weyer covered the back of the residence, coming in on foot from Lutheran High School. Officer Garber and I attempted contact at the residence. I pounded on the door for several minutes, but there was no answer. Officer Garber and I then went to trailer number 36, as this is the residence of GARY and KIM HARRISON, who are the parents of BRIANNE, and from past experience I knew they usually kept a close eye on their daughter's trailer. They were not home either.

It should be noted that officers did not specifically check each door and window of trailer #35, but everything appeared to be normal. The window off the kitchen also appeared to be in its usual condition – slightly ajar. I had been to the LOPEZ residence on 10-27-05 and 11-04-05 for family trouble calls, and had on both occasions noticed this window ajar. Later at 1738 hours, LOPEZ contacted the PD to report a burglary to his residence and the point of entry was through this window, and the screen was now cut as well. See 2005- 00012628, Officer Schaefer's report.

Sgt. Leist had obtained information from another Officer that the victim, CHARLENE had been seeing a new boyfriend named JASON ROSS. The same three officers and I went to that residence located at 1708 Meadowbrook Dr. at about 1600 hours. Enroute, I asked dispatch by phone if they could run an R-Hoss through State Patrol on both the victim and the suspect so Officers could know what possible vehicles the suspect may be driving. Sgt. Leist and Officer Weyer watched the outside of the building while Officer Garber and I attempted contact. Before we were able to knock on ROSS' door, we met the building manager, LAURA DEWANE and her daughter DONNA PRITZL, in the hallway. DEWANE and PRITZL informed us that they had just been knocking on ROSS' door with no answer. It should be noted that both DEWANE and PRITZL were already aware of the incident involving. PRITZL informed me that she works with CHARLENE at RIVERS BEND HEALTH CARE FACILITY. PRITZL suggested to me that I speak to CHAELENE'S other good friend and coworker, JENNIFER SKROVE-HUYCKE. PRITZL said she might be able to provide me with information about CHARLENE and MARTINEZ.

They said they were also concerned about ROSS' safety. She also told me that she had given the 1991 black Chevy Cavalier to CHARLENE, which CHARLENE usually drives. Officers went to ROSS' apartment with DEWANE and PRITZL. We knocked on the door but there was no answer. Given the circumstances of the incident and through concern for ROSS' safety, I asked DEWANE to use her master key to unlock ROSS' apartment so we could make a sweep and ascertain that he had not been harmed and was in need of help within the apartment. When the apartment door was opened, I found that the safety chain was latched. I called into the apartment and then a black male subject came to the door. He allowed officers into the apartment, and he was identified as JASON ROSS.

At first ROSS said he had been sleeping and had not heard us knocking. He later admitted that he simply did not want to have contact with the Police. He was told that we wanted to make sure that he was safe, given his relationship with CHARLENE and the incident, which had occurred. When we told

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him what had happened to CHARLENE, he insisted that he had gotten a phone call from her a short time ago. He said when he had gotten this call he had been sleeping. He said he had been told that CHARLENE'S mother had been attacked by MARTINEZ. We informed him that that was not the case, and that CHARLENE had been the victim in this incident. He told us that he knows MARTINEZ (the suspect) and had met him once or twice. ROSS stated that one of the reasons he did not want to answer the door was because MARTINEZ had been knocking on his door the night before, looking for CHARLENE.

I asked ROSS to explain that in detail to me, and also tell me when was the last time he had seen CHARLENE. ROSS stated that when CHARLENE had gotten off work at 0600 hours on Friday, Nov. 4th, she came over to his apartment. He said she was there until about 1330 hours on 11-05-05 (today's date.) He stated that they stayed in his apartment except for a short time when he left and drove CHARLENE'S car to go get some food and alcohol. He said at about 2100 hours on 11-04-05, there was a pounding on his door and MARTINEZ was outside the door and told ROSS to have CHARLENE come outside because he knew she was in there. He said he spoke to MARTINEZ through the door and lied to him and told him CHARLENE was not inside his apartment. He said MARTINEZ yelled and told him that he knew she was in there as he had followed her to the apartment. ROSS said he again told him that she was not at the apartment and MARTINEZ then left and went outside and came by the patio door. ROSS said he was there for just a short time and then he left.

ROSS said at about 0730 on 11-05-05, he was going to drive to the ATM machine and use CHARLENE'S car, but it was gone from where he had parked it the night before. He said when he told CHARLENE her car was gone, she stated to him that she now remembered hearing a car drive past the apartment which had sounded like her vehicle. ROSS stated that CHARLENE was going to report her vehicle as stolen, but she did not want to report it stolen from ROSS' apartment complex, as she did not want him involved in any Police report. ROSS said CHARLENE decided to wait until she arrived back home to her Franklin St. address before reporting the vehicle stolen to Police, and that she would claim the vehicle was stolen from the Franklin St. address.

ROSS said CHARLENE was at his residence up until about 1330 hours. He said she had received a phone call from her [redacted] at about 1300 hours, who told her that her [redacted] had been involved in some type of accident. [redacted] came and picked up CHARLENE and that was the last he heard from her. We informed ROSS that CHARLENE was currently in [redacted] and that the suspect, MARTINEZ, had not yet been located. ROSS stated he would be staying at his apartment. We told him that if he even suspected MARTINEZ was outside his apartment that he should dial 911 immediately. ROSS was asked if he knew of any places where MARTINEZ may be hiding. He stated that he works with VICTOR COTA, and he knows that MARTINEZ' son (JAMES NETTLES) is VICTOR'S best friend. He said MARTINEZ might be a COTA'S home.

Officer Garber and I left ROSS' apartment. Sgt. Leist and Officer Weyer had already freed up after it was determined MARTINEZ was not at the apartment. Sgt. Leist now radioed us that he had a family member in his squad (CHARLENE'S [redacted]) who was going to show us a home to check for the suspect, which was just outside the southern city limits. We met Sgt. Leist and Officer Weyer at Silver Creek Park, and drove to 3703 S 10TH St., which is the home of JAMES NETTLES grandfather and the current residence of NETTLES as well. The time was 1653 hours. Contact was made with NETTLES. He allowed Officers to search the farmhouse and MARTINEZ was not located. I asked NETTLES when he had last seen his father. He stated that MARTINEZ had picked him up at about 1100 hours, and they drove to AVERY'S salvage yard, as NETTLES car had been towed there earlier in the week.

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NETTLES said when they arrived there; MTSO duties would not allow them in (due to the investigation of the missing Calumet County woman.) He said they drove back to his home and his father dropped him off at about noon. That was the last he had seen of him. Officers then left the residence.

At 1733 hours, Officers Garber, Weyer and I went to the home of VICTOR COTA. Dispatch meanwhile had provided me with the results of the R-Hoss search through State Patrol. There were two vehicles listed to CHARLENE and six listed to MARTINEZ, including a 1984 Ford truck. Officers then learned from Officer Stone, that the 1991 Chevy Cavalier which CHARLENE usually drives, and which we believed MARTINEZ had the keys to from taking it from the Meadowbrook apartment complex, was at the Franklin St. address. We made contact with COTA and his father. COTA stated MARTINEZ was not at his home. The home was not searched; as COTA'S father also said he was not there. COTA said he was aware of the incident involving CHARLENE due to media coverage. Officers left the residence and Officer Garber and I then returned to the Department and took separate squads, as I had been hoping to go and speak with SKROVE-HUYCKE.

Just as I was leaving the PD however, dispatch asked me to call in and informed me that they had just taken a complaint of a burglary to the LOPEZ residence. They were assigning Officer Schaefer to the call and I also responded to speak to LOPEZ and HARRISON about where they had been and if they knew where MARTINEZ might be. When I arrived with Officer Schaefer, we made contact with both LOPEZ and HARRISON. LOPEZ stated they had arrived home at about 1700 hours. (I later learned from Officer Block, who had been processing evidence at the crime scene, that he had observed LOPEZ show up at the crime scene while it was still light outside. Sunset at this time of year is about 1640 hours.) He said he first noticed the screen was cut on the kitchen window at about 1730 hours. He claimed the kitchen window had been shut tight. When I told him the window appeared to be in the same condition as it was the last two times I had been at his residence (minus the cut screen) he then stated he believed the window had been shut tighter then it currently was.

I asked LOPEZ where they had been at about 1530 hours today. He stated to me that he, HARRISON, COTA and his mother had gone to an auction out on Hwy 310. He said they arrived home about 1700 hours. LOPEZ was claiming \$2300.00 cash was missing from a shoebox in his bedroom. Knowing neither LOPEZ nor HARRISON was employed, I asked him where he had obtained \$2300.00. He stated he "works for cash" doing odd jobs. I asked him if they had had anyone over to the home recently that may have known where the money was located in the home (as nothing else was disturbed). He said at first that last night the only persons at his trailer were himself, HARRISON, and COTA. When pressed if anyone else had been at the trailer, he added MARTINEZ. Both he and HARRISON then stated they had heard about the incident involving CHARLENE from COTA'S mother, who had called LOPEZ mother. They also stated they had heard we had MARTINEZ in custody (but we did not.)

Just at that moment, Officer Weyer knocked on the door of the trailer. He had wanted to reach me by Nextel, but knew I was busy. He pulled me aside and told me that a tip had come in that MARTINEZ may be at VAN'S TAVERN. I left the LOPEZ residence and went with Officer Weyer and Garber to check that location. Officer Schaefer continued to investigate the LOPEZ burglary. Officers did not locate MARTINEZ at VAN'S, but a person Officer Weyer spoke to lead to another possibility that MARTINEZ may be at TJ'S tavern. We went there and did not locate MARTINEZ. At this time, I spoke with Detectives Habeck and Swetlik. I told them Officer Schaefer was investigating a burglary at the LOPEZ residence, and I knew from past experience that MARTINEZ stayed there. They went to

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this residence and myself, Officer Schaefer and the Detectives were about to question LOPEZ further, when dispatch asked that I speak on the phone with LINDA CZEKALA, who may have information about this incident. The Detectives and Officer Schaefer did speak to LOPEZ and HARRISON further, but I was not present, as I was speaking to CZEKALA in the squad by phone.

CZEKALA told me that her daughter, HEATHER KRAEMER, has a relationship with JOEY GOLDEN, but the two are no longer together. She went on and told me that last week; GOLDEN had shown up at her home with a black Ford Bronco. GOLDEN claimed he had purchased the vehicle from "a friend" who was going to be going to prison soon, for \$250.00. He asked CZEKALA if she wanted the vehicle, as he had no use for it. She said GOLDEN said he did not have a valid DL and so he did not want the vehicle. CZEKALA said she had later learned that the vehicle had been MARTINEZ vehicle or may still be his vehicle. She stated she was now scared to death that MARTINEZ may be coming to her house to get the vehicle. I asked her to go outside and obtain a license plate off the vehicle. She informed me that there was a WIRP Temp plate of AF2836 on the vehicle. I asked her to get a VIN off the vehicle, either by the dash or the inside door. She returned and stated the VIN plate had been removed from the dash, and the VIN sticker on the door was unreadable. I asked her to at least take a photo of the vehicle, in case MARTINEZ did return and take it. I asked her if she knew where JOEY GOLDEN was living, because if GOLDEN was friends with MARTINEZ, he may be staying with him. CZEKALA told me that last she knew, JOEY was living in the 1900 block of Washington St. She described the house to me and I was familiar with it. I told CZEKALA to immediately call 911 if she believed anyone was lurking around her home.

Officer Weyer then contacted me and told me that he had been checking local motels and found out from the clerk at the HERITAGE INN, that earlier in the afternoon, a person matching MARTINEZ'S description, had come into the motel and wanted to rent a room. Officer Weyer had shown the photo we had of MARTINEZ to the clerk and the clerk had stated that was the man who wanted a room. The clerk stated MARTINEZ decided not to rent the room when he learned how much it was. The man stated he was going to "shop around, but might be back." The man was also with another man, who was described to Officer Weyer as Filipino looking. I went to Officer Weyer's location and we then made a check of GOLDDIGERS tavern, but MARTINEZ was not located.

Officer Weyer and I then went to 1916A Washington St.; to check what we believed was the JOEY GOLDEN residence. We located mail in the mailbox for GOLDEN. There was also a TV on inside the upper apartment, but no one answered the door.

At 2115 hours, I then went to RIVERS BEND, to speak to JENNIFER SKROVE-HUYCKE. I learned that she and CHARLENE are not only friends and co-workers, but JENNIFER is also CHARLENE'S supervisor. JENNIFER informed me that CHARLENE had confided in her about the rocky relationship she has had with MARTINEZ, and that he beat on her. JENNIFER told me that about three weeks ago, CHARLENE had told her that she had called the Police after being beat by MARTINEZ and he was arrested and put in jail. JENNIFER said that CHARLENE believed MARTINEZ'S PO would hold him in jail but he was released. JENNIFER stated after MARTINEZ was released, that CHARLENE began to show up at work with more and worse injuries caused by MARTINEZ beatings. JENNIFER said that CHARLENE told her last weekend that MARTINEZ had said that he could handle them not being together (apparently there was an injunction and the two were not supposed to have contact with each other) but if he (MARTINEZ) found out she (CHARLENE) was cheating on him that he would "bury us both." JENNIFER stated she believed MARTINEZ was due to appear in court on 11-07-05 from this DVO charge. JENNIFER said she believed MARTINEZ

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drove a black Ford Bronco. (The vehicle now at the CZEKALA residence.) She also informed me that on several occasions in the past, Martinez had come to check up on CHARLENE while she was at work. She said their facility was currently under a lock down, as they feared MARTINEZ might come there.

At 2136 hours, I spoke to HEATHER KRAEMER, who was also on duty and who is the daughter of LINDA CZEKALA. She stated that it was a possibility that MARTINEZ was with JOEY GOLDEN. She said she knew GOLDEN was currently living with a girl named TERESA who is with his and who lives in Whitelaw. She did not know TERESA'S last name, but she said JENNA JOHNSRUD would, as she is a friend of TERESA'S. I was familiar with JOHNSRUD from past experience. HEATHER told me that she knew the Ford Bronco belonged to MARTINEZ, and that GOLDEN and MARTINEZ made regular runs to the Milwaukee area to obtain crack and other drugs. Heather told me that from what she knew, MARTINEZ had a girlfriend named TARA NOVAK. She said she believed she lived on Huron St. She stated NOVAK and MARTINEZ were "crack buddies." Heather also told me that she knew that when CHARLENE and MARTINEZ were no longer living together, that she knew MARTINEZ was living with CARLOS LOPEZ. CHARLENE had also told HEATHER that MARTINEZ had made the statement that he would kill her if he found out she was cheating on him.

After leaving RIVERS BEND, I returned to the PD and spoke to detectives Swetlik and Habeck to compare information obtained. Det. Habeck was familiar with NOVAK'S mother, DONNA EISENCHINK. He called her and she informed him that her daughter was currently in Peshtigo at . I also called JOHNSRUD. She informed me that TERESA living with JOEY GOLDEN was TERESA HANSON. HANSON'S address was obtained and this information was passed on to MTSO, to have them check this address for MARTINEZ. I later learned MTSO did check this residence and they were told MARTINEZ was never at that home.

On 11-05-05 at 1543 hours I, Officer Block, responded to 1905 FRANKLIN ST. to process the crime scene. On arrival, I spoke to Det. Trilling. He advised that exterior photos were taken of the scene, including the residence of 1905 FRANKLIN ST.

Det. Trilling then directed me into the backyard, and stated that the hatchet was lying in the backyard. The hatchet had a wooden handle and was facing in a southeast direction. The hatchet handle was 42 ½ inches south of the south side of the residence. The hatchet handle was also 6' 8" west of the southeast corner of the residence. A rough sketch was made of the positioning of the hatchet, including the backside of the residence. Sgt. Flemal completed the sketch. The hatchet was marked as Evidence Item #1. The hatchet was placed in a cardboard box and tied down using two tie downs. It should be noted that there appeared to be a red substance on the blade of the hatchet.

Prior to entering the residence, Officer Stone and I, Officer Block, checked the back porch and driveway for any blood stains/spatter. One drop of what appeared to be dried was located on the concrete, just to the west of the back porch. The drop/spatter was marked as Evidence Item #2. Prior to taking the swab, I placed distilled water on a sterilized cotton swab. A swab was taken of the dark red substance. The swab was placed in a swab box. No other drops/spatter were found outside on the concrete or on the back porch.

Next, Officer Stone and I, Officer Block, entered 1905 FRANKLIN ST. at the rear entrance (southwest side of residence). Entry into the house was at 1655 hours. Prior to entry, we put coverings over our shoes to protect the interior crime scene. Upon entry, a walkthrough was conducted of the residence. Officer Stone advised me of the witness statements and briefed me on what occurred.

I then took photos of the interior of the residence. Photos were mostly taken of the kitchen, as Officer Stone advised this is where the crime would have occurred. Photos were taken of the pantry and breezeway, which lead to the rear exit. After photos were taken, I began evidence collection. It should be noted that the purse, which was lying on the kitchen floor, was marked as Evidence Item #3. Photos were taken of the purse, but I did not collect it as evidence. It was marked as evidence to show it in relation to the other items in the kitchen. The keys (Evidence Item #4), wooden door (Evidence Item #7), and two shoes (Evidence Item #5 and 6), were also located in the kitchen. Photos were taken of each, but I did not collect these items. They were marked to show these items in relation to the other items in the kitchen.

I then took swabs of the evidence, which was located in the kitchen. The items were marked as Evidence Items #8,#9,#11. It should be noted that Item #11 was located in the pantry doorway, just to the south of the kitchen. The substance was on the end of a wooden end panel. The Item appeared to be a dried spot of . Prior to taking swabs, photos were taken of each item. Each of the swabs was taken using a sterile swab with distilled water. Each item was then properly packaged.

I also collected Item #10. Item #10 was a clump of what appeared to be human hair. The hair was clumped together and was being held together by a red substance, which appeared to be . The substance was already dry. Using a disposable tweezers, I collected the clump of hair. The clump of hair was placed onto a trace evidence sheet of paper. The paper was folded using a pharmaceutical fold. The items were then placed into an envelope and marked as Evidence Item #10. It should be noted that in checking the kitchen, that there was a large amount of dog hair on the floor.

It should be noted that Officer Stone completed a rough sketch of the interior of the kitchen. That sketch has been attached.

I completed the evidence collection at 1912 hours. I then transported the collected evidence items to MTPD Evidence Room. The items were sealed and placed into the Evidence Room at 1930 hours. The evidence was marked with evidence Tag #30437. See attached Evidence Log.

For further details of this report, see Officer Stone's report.

The film used to take photos of the crime scene was placed in the evidence room refrigerator. The film is ready for process.

On 11/05/05 at 1615 hours I, Detective Swetlik, reported to the MTPD to assist officers in the handling of an assault-type incident involving ANDRES MARTINEZ as the suspect. A short time later Detective Habeck reported to the MTPD to assist me in the investigation.

Deputy Chief Tony Dick met with us at the MTPD and briefed us on what he knew up to that point and what other officers were doing pertaining to this case. It was apparent to me at that time that the most important thing was to attempt to locate ANDRES MARTINEZ and to secure the safety of CHARLENE EDWARDS at HFMMC. I was informed that Sgt Waskow was at HFMMC guarding CHARLENE EDWARDS at this time while she's being treated for her wounds.

I, Detective Swetlik, along with Detective Habeck, then went to the scene at the CHARLENE EDWARDS' residence on Franklin St to check up on the officers there. We arrived at the EDWARDS' residence on Franklin St and spoke with Officers Block and Stone who were gathering evidence from the scene. Officer Block had a few questions as to what should be taken into evidence pertaining to that scene. We spoke with both Officer Stone and Officer Block, giving them some directives and also receiving information from them on what they had and what evidence existed at the scene.

At that point, I, Detective Swetlik, along with Detective Habeck went to HFMMC and spoke with Sgt Waskow who was with CHARLENE EDWARDS at that time. At the time we were at HFMMC, we did speak with Sgt Waskow who informed us that at this time CHARLENE EDWARDS was receiving a and would not be able to communicate with us. Sgt Waskow informed us that at that point it appeared that CHARLENE EDWARDS was going to survive the wounds she suffered and would be confined to the hospital for some time. Sgt Waskow asked how long she would be required to stay with CHARLENE EDWARDS.

I then spoke with Security Personnel at HFMMC and informed them of the situation surrounding CHARLENE EDWARDS. I also made arrangements for Officer Garber to bring to HFMMC a copy of the photo of ANDRES MARTINEZ so that numerous copies could be made and given out to Security Personnel and Office Personnel surrounding the HFMMC. We were informed by Security Personnel that HFMMC was currently under a lockdown and security precautions were taking place. We were informed that after the , CHARLENE EDWARDS would be placed in a room at an unknown location within the hospital at HFMMC. I informed Hospital Security Personnel that if ANDRES MARTINEZ attempts in any way to enter the facility or is even seen anywhere near that facility, they are to call the PD as soon as possible so that squads may be sent to intercept. I also informed Security Personnel that once CHARLENE EDWARDS is placed in a private room that our officer would be pulled from the scene and we would be instructing our department to keep HFMMC out of any communications on the police radio so that ANDRES MARTINEZ does not have an idea where CHARLENE EDWARDS is being kept at this time. We were also informed by Sgt Waskow that there are approximately 15-20 family members belonging to CHARLENE EDWARDS that are at the hospital wanting to stay with her during this time.

We were then informed that Sgt Zimney along with Officer Garber were in the process of attempting to locate ANDRES MARTINEZ and were going throughout the city making contacts at local hotels, taverns, friends, etc. We made arrangements to speak with Sgt Zimney and were going to make arrangements to meet him at 3910 Waldo Blvd #35 in Manitowoc. That would be the manufactured

home belonging to CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA HARRISON. Prior to going to 3910 Waldo Blvd #35, we were going to stop at LARRY'S SHELL in Manitowoc where the Greyhound Bus Service has a terminal. We were also informed that Officer Schaefer was at 3910 Waldo Blvd #35 in Manitowoc standing by.

We then went to the LARRY'S SHELL and spoke with personnel on duty regarding the bus stop. We were informed that one bus had left earlier in the evening and one person boarded that bus. We were given a description of the individual that boarded that bus and it did not in any way fit the description of ANDRES MARTINEZ. We were then informed by personnel at LARRY'S SHELL that the next bus would be leaving at 8:20 PM but that bus would be heading NB. We were also informed that at 4:20 AM a bus heading SB would be leaving LARRY'S SHELL. We informed the personnel at LARRY'S SHELL that we will get a photograph of ANDRES MARTINEZ and bring that photographed out to them so that they can use it for comparison on anyone boarding the Greyhound Bus Service. We informed the individuals at LARRY'S SHELL that if they observed this individual entering their facility that they are to not look obvious but call the PD so that we can respond and apprehend the individual.

We then went to 3910 Waldo Blvd #35 in Manitowoc and met up with Officer Schaefer. Officer Schaefer began to explain the situation at the home belonging to CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA HARRISON. Sgt Zimney then pulled up to the area and also sat with us and explained what he has come up with so far. After being informed of the situation involving CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA HARRISON, we then again went to speak with CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA HARRISON in the mobile home at 3910 Waldo Blvd #35. CARLOS LOPEZ went on to inform me that he is indeed very good friends with ANDRES MARTINEZ as is BRIANNA HARRISON. CARLOS LOPEZ informed us that ANDRES MARTINEZ has been staying out at their trailer quite a few times in the past, since the trouble he has been experiencing with CHARLENE EDWARDS. I was also informed by CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA HARRISON that they are very good friends with CHARLENE EDWARDS and do not like to take sides in any way with their dispute between themselves. I explained to CARLOS LOPEZ that we would need to speak with ANDRES MARTINEZ and that at this time it appears that CHARLENE EDWARDS will be all right and that sooner or later we would catch up with ANDRES MARTINEZ and at this point it would be better that we speak with him about the situation before something else would happen. CARLOS LOPEZ stated that at this time he is unsure if ANDRES MARTINEZ would contact him but there would be very good chance that if he was in the area he would. I asked CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA HARRISON, who or where might ANDRES MARTINEZ stay with while he is on the run. CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA HARRISON stated that they are not really sure where he may be staying although he does have some acquaintances in town. CARLOS LOPEZ informed me that there would be a good chance that ANDRES MARTINEZ would stay with a friend of his by the name of BUSTER KNAPP who lives on 9th St, somewhere by Lincoln High School. CARLOS LOPEZ also stated that ANDRES MARTINEZ does have a lot of connections in the Milwaukee area since that is where he went and was employed after his release from prison some years ago. CARLOS LOPEZ also informed me, after I did some inquiring, that ANDRES MARTINEZ does have an issue with drugs and his drug of choice would probably be Rock Crack.

I, Detective Swetlik, along with Detective Habeck then spoke again with Sgt Zimney and Officer Schaefer regarding the case and where we want to go with it at this point as far as attempting to locate

ANDRES MARTINEZ. Sgt Zimney stated that he was going to attempt to follow up on some other leads he had with friends (see Sgt Zimney's addition) and I, Detective Swetlik, along with Detective Habeck were going to get the photograph out to the Greyhound Bus Service and attempt to locate this BUSTER KNAPP's house on S 9th St.

I, Detective Swetlik, along with Detective Habeck found out that BUSTER KNAPP is actually KENNETH DOUGLAS KNAPP who lives at 1314 S 9th St, Manitowoc. We went to 1314 S 9th St in Manitowoc and an effort to contact BUSTER KNAPP regarding ANDRES MARTINEZ. We knocked on the door at 1314 S 9th St in Manitowoc and received no answer on numerous tries. I did notice that there were no lights on in the inside of the residence, although there appeared to be a TV playing in the living room.

At that point we went to the scene on Franklin St and combed the area within a few block radius attempting to maybe find ANDRES MARTINEZ possibly walking since things have settled down in that area at that time. There were very few people walking at that time since it was raining extremely hard and somewhat windy.

We then drove by KENNETH KNAPP's residence at 1314 S 9th St and everything appeared to be as it was when we were there earlier with no movement visible.

I, Detective Swetlik, along with Detective Habeck then reported back to the PD. I then made contact with Lt Boldt regarding the probation/parole pickup that we were going to have placed on ANDRES MARTINEZ. I was informed by Lt Boldt that he attempted to contact DON VOGT who is the supervisor for Probation & Parole in the Manitowoc area but was unsuccessful. I, Detective Swetlik, then attempted contact with DON VOGT but received no answer on his home phone and cellphone number. I then found out that DON STEFANCIC is actually ANDRES MARTINEZ's Probation Officer at this time. I attempted to contact DON STEFANCIC at his home phone number but was also unsuccessful in contacting him. I then contacted Probation & Parole Officer DOUGLAS SUNDSMO at his home residence. Probation & Parole Officer DOUGLAS SUNDSMO did answer the phone and I explained the situation involving ANDRES MARTINEZ to him. DOUGLAS SUNDSMO informed me that he would report to his office of Probation & Parole immediately and file a pickup on ANDRES MARTINEZ regarding this incident. I informed DOUGLAS SUNDSMO that I appreciate his efforts at this time of the evening and will inform our officers of the pickup. DOUGLAS SUNDSMO informed me that it would take approximately an hour to an hour and half to actually prepare the paperwork for the pickup and that he would notify the agencies involving the pickup.

It should be noted that when speaking with Officer Stone at the scene I was informed that all the witnesses at the scene, that being family members, did write out statements pertaining to what they saw and experienced with ANDRES MARTINEZ at the residence. I also informed that CHARLENE EDWARDS was able to communicate but at that time not able to write. I was informed that she did give some statements, ID'ing ANDRES MARTINEZ as the one that did the damage to her.

At that point we were not able to get a written statement from CHARLENE EDWARDS and was informed that officers will be following up on obtaining a statement from her as her medical condition betters and she's able to actually write one out.

11/05/05: I made phone contact with DONNA EISENSCHINK who is the mother of TARA NOVAK. Sgt Zimney had earlier obtained information that TARA NOVAK should be [redacted] ANDRES MARTINEZ's [redacted] and may possibly be on ANDRES' transportation to get out of town.

Upon questioning DONNA concerning TARA's relationship with ANDRES, she stated that she has heard the name ANDRES but does not think TARA is going out with him or anything like that. She said TARA is [redacted] but that the [redacted] of her child is ABRAHAM ARRIAGA who is no longer in this area. DONNA said TARA is in Peshtigo today for her [redacted] and should be home later tonight some time. I asked DONNA if she could have TARA contact me and gave her my phone number.

11/07/05: On 11/05/05 we had developed information that KENNETH KNAPP (BUSTER) who resides at 1314 S 9th St should be a close friend to ANDRES MARTINEZ. On today's date I made contact with KENNETH KNAPP at 0745 hours. KEN said he had heard what had taken place but he has not seen ANDRES MARTINEZ since. He said on Saturday, ANDRES MARTINEZ, should have stopped at his residence around 2:15 in the afternoon. KEN said he was not home at the time but that their babysitter told them ANDRES had stopped. The babysitter who is CHRIS GLASOW informed them that ANDRES had been driving a little black car. KEN acknowledged he has been friends with ANDRES since they were 18 YOA. He said he is not sure where ANDRES would go but that he hoped ANDRES would turn himself in. KEN stated he would give us a call should ANDRES show up.

11/07/05: I proceeded to HFMMC where I made contact with CHARLENE EDWARDS. CHARLENE stated she is still sore and in pain but that things are slowly getting better. I asked CHARLENE if some time today she would be up to filling out a written statement on the incident as well as their personal lives and what had led up to this incident. CHARLENE informed me that some of her friends or relatives would be stopping by later in the day and she would have them assist her in filling out this statement. I advised CHARLENE to contact me when the statements are finished. Later in the day, I also had CHARLENE sign a Non-Consent form and Detective Tech took photos concerning some of the [redacted] and [redacted] which now are quite visible. I asked CHARLENE concerning where she thought ANDRES might go. CHARLENE stated that ANDRES has family in Florida and also a brother down in Texas. She said a friend of hers, HEATHER KRAEMER (sp?) should have knowledge concerning a trailer owned by Terry Schindler somewhere in the County. She said there is a chance that ANDRES could be at that location. CHARLENE informed me that she is still quite tired due to the medications and she would like to get some rest.

11/07/05: I proceeded to 910 Huron St where I made contact with DONNA EISENSCHINK and her daughter, TARA NOVAK. I asked TARA concerning her relationship with ANDRES MARTINEZ. TARA stated she knows ANDRES MARTINEZ but she does not have any type of relationship with him whatsoever. She said ANDRES likes her and has told others that she is his girlfriend but that is not true. She said the [redacted] she is carrying belongs to ABRAHAM ARRIAGA and that she has not ever had any sexual contact with ANDRES MARTINEZ. She did state on Friday she saw ANDRES riding his bike at Walmart. She said on Saturday she was in Peshtigo and did not get home until late. I asked TARA as to where she thought ANDRES might go. She said ANDRES has lot of friends, including CARLOS LOPEZ and BRIANNA who live at 3910 Waldo Blvd #35. She also said CARLOS may be staying with JASON MARTELL who lives some place behind Younkers. TARA stated should she hear anything concerning ANDRES, she would call.

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11-13-05

Sgt Joy Brixius of the MTSO Jail contacted our department stating she had information from one of their inmates. She said KENNETH JACKSON had heard that MARTINEZ had said he was going to do this to CHARLENE when he got out. I spoke with Sgt Joy Brixius by phone. She stated that KENNETH JACKSON and ANDRES MARTINEZ were in the same cellblock while he was incarcerated back in the end of October, beginning of November. She said she would be able to check the exact dates when she returns to work. I asked Sgt Brixius to fill out a short typed statement and forward that to me.

11/07/05: I proceeded to the MTSO Jail where I made contact with KENNETH JACKSON. KENNETH confirmed he had given some information to one of the jailers concerning what he had heard MARTINEZ say. JACKSON confirmed he was in the same cellblock as ANDRES MARTINEZ. He said ANDRES was talking to some of the Mexicans and told them "He'd be coming back". He then heard MARTINEZ say, "The bitch don't know what she did and whose she's fucking with." JACKSON stated then a second time he heard MARTINEZ say this was the day he was getting out of jail. JACKSON said he told ANDRES, "Don't be coming back." He said ANDRES winked at him and said, "I'll be right back." I asked JACKSON what he thought ANDRES meant and he said he thought ANDRES was going to jump on CHARLENE again. He stated he did not think ANDRES would try to kill her but just jump on her. JACKSON said he is familiar with ANDRES MARTINEZ and CHARLENE EDWARDS. He said he received a puppy from CHARLENE EDWARDS when their dog had a litter and that he knows CHARLENE has had a hard past where she was beat up by her ex-husband and now ANDRES. He stated that he doesn't like ANDRES and that he felt ANDRES had no right to do this to CHARLENE. JACKSON requested I fill out the statement for him. I then read the statement back to KENNETH JACKSON who signed the bottom of the statement.

When thinking it over, he stated he should've called yesterday that ANDRES might be staying on his property in the Co. TERRY gave us permission to scale his wall and check his property at 2402 NELSON RD. Officers Buck and Sgt Perronne positioned themselves on the NORTHSIDE outside of the fenced area while Det. Habeck and Officer D Le Duc entered from the SOUTHSIDE.

I learned later that ANDRES had seen the Officers coming in from the SOUTH. ANDRES was going to take off running when he noticed Officer outside the fence. This area covers approximately 1-½ acres and had about 20-30 junked vehicles along with several outside the building. We were unable to gain entrance to a motor home on the property and contact TERRY SCHINDLER who climbed in the front window and ANDRES came out the back door and surrendered. ANDRES was transported to the Police Department in squad #53 and Det. Habeck followed me in. ANDRES was turned over to Det. Habeck and I drove to BURGER KING and picked up lunch for ANDRES. (Fish sandwich, hamburger, fries and a soda). While driving ANDRES to the Police Department after taking him into custody he had made several utterances. He stated that, "I wasn't trying to kill her," pointing that he had had several times he could have done that. He stated he had thought of turning himself in by tonight. He had also thought about gassing himself.

On 11/07/05 I, Sgt Perronne, was approached by Lt Schweigl that he had spoke to Officer Le Duc reference follow up on information obtained about ANDRES MARTINEZ's whereabouts. Lt Schweigl and Officer Le Duc informed me that they believed that ANDRES MARTINEZ may be staying at 2402 Nelson Rd. Manitowoc, Wisconsin Officer Le Duc, Lt Schweigl, Officer Buck, Detective Habeck and myself met in Lt Schweigl's office and set up a plan of action in an attempt to make contact with ANDRES MARTINEZ for the above incident.

It was it was determined that Officer Buck and myself would secure the perimeter of the fence in area while Detective Habeck and Officer Le Duc would attempt to locate the party by entering the front gate of the enclosed area at 2402 Nelson Rd. Detective Habeck and Officer Le Duc did a systematic search of the area and informed me of a motor home which was locked. Officer Le Duc told me access could not be gained except by calling the property owner. Officer Le Duc called the owner to respond to allow Police access for clearing the motor home. Officer Le Duc told me the Northern end of the property was secured. Upon hearing this I told Officer Buck to change his position. Officer Buck was told to enter the property from the main gate and hold a position monitoring the motor home while Detective Habeck and Le Duc finished the search of the property.

Officer Le Duc and Detective Habeck cleared the Northeast side of the property where I was located. I then entered the enclosed area to assist clearing the property. We clear the rest of the property except a gray steel building that was padlocked and secured with no obvious signs of entry. Officer stood by until the property owner arrived.

TERRY SCHINDLER, the property owner who responded arrived at our location to provide us access to those two areas of the property. TERRY was informed that access could not be gained into the two locations. TERRY informed Officer Le Duc that the RV should not be locked. He stated that the key was kept inside the camper and it is not locked. TERRY volunteered to gain access through the driver's window on the driver's side of the vehicle. Upon entering, I observed him crawl into the camper and proceed to the door where he opened the door. Upon opening the door I, Sgt Perronne, saw ANDRES MARTINEZ standing in the camper with his hands up. TERRY told ANDRES he had no choice. ANDRES said he understood.

ANDRES MARTINEZ was advised that he was being taken into custody. He was requested to keep his hands up in sight. He was ordered to turn away from me. I placed him into compliance and he was handcuffed. The handcuffs placed in the handcuff groove, checked for tightness and double-locked. He was searched incident to arrest. I located in his front left pocket was a clear plastic baggie along with seven white oblong pills with an insignia number of L484 on each pill. It was later determined that the pills were actually aspirin by using the Drug Bible at the Police Department. ANDRES told me he takes the pills for While looking at the plastic bag closer I observed small particles of a green leafy substance. This green leafy substance would be consistent with THC. Located in his front right pocket I located a pill bottle which was issued to him from Walmart Pharmacies and it said that it was and was issued by a See photocopies of the pill bottle attached to the report.

Officer Buck and I searched the area search incident to arrest where ANDRES was taken into custody. ANDRES jacket which was black in color was located along with a note on a notepad that said, "Things I just gotta get done or else". The notepad was from Your Friendly Professionals at Jimmy

Jim's Quick Print at 1517 Washington St, Manitowoc. Handwritten on the notepad were several names. The names consisted of JAMES, ANTONIO, FAITH, MIKE, and EDDY and it said, "I love you I love you all". See a copy of the note attached with report. Also located was a plastic card with CHARLENE EDWARDS name on it.

Officer Le Duc, while standing by with ANDRES, had received the statement from ANDRES that he had thought about gassing himself. The gas was turned off on the outside of the camper where ANDRES told Officer Le Duc he had turned it on.

ANDRES was escorted to squad #53 by Officer Le Duc and me. Just prior to getting to the squad, ANDRES asked me how CHARLENE was. I told ANDRES that my understanding that she was stabilized in the hospital. ANDRES, upon placing him into the secure area of squad #53, made an utterance at 1120hrs, "I don't know what happened to me. I don't know what was going through my mind." He was secured in the back of squad #53. Upon closing the door of the squad I asked Officer Le Duc the time and wrote down the statements for my notes. Officer Le Duc also acknowledged hearing the statements. Officer Le Duc transported ANDRES to the Police Department for an interview.

The note and notepad, plastic bag and pills were tagged with Property Evidence Tag #30447 and placed in the Property Evidence Room at 1507 hours at the MTPD in Locker #7. ANDRE's medication was later turned over to MTSO correctional personnel.

ANDRES advised Officer Le Duc and Detective Habeck that he wished to have something to drink and hadn't eaten for several days. It was determined that Detective Habeck would get him some water and Officer Le Duc would obtain some food for him and provide it to him in the interview room at the MTPD in the Detective Bureau. ANDRE's handcuffs were removed. He was directed into the interview room in the Detective Bureau at the MTPD. He was provided a plastic cup of water and allowed to drink his water. ANDRES was asked if he would be willing to speak with us and he said he would. He was informed that the interview would be recorded. The tape from the interview was tagged with Property Evidence Tag #30448.

ANDRES was informed that Detective Habeck and I, Sgt Perronne, wished to interview him. Detective Habeck read his Miranda Warning at 1154 hours which I witnessed, see signed by ANDRES MARTINEZ, copy attached to the report. MARTINEZ was asked if he understood his rights and he said yes. He asked if he had understood English and spoke it fluently and he said he did. ANDRES said he spoke English for eighteen years. He was asked if he wanted a translator and he said no. The interview began with his consent and was recorded as listed above. See complete transcript of entire interview. An initial summary of the interview is as follows:

He informed Detective Habeck and myself that he had known CHARLENE EDWARDS, the victim, for approximately since she had been 13 or 14 YOA. He stated that he cared for her with his heart. He told us he had been living with her for three years and dated her when she was younger. He informed us that for the past eight months he and CHARLENE had been doing "heavy drugs." (Crack Cocaine) He also stated that there were some other drugs that had been used. He stated that they were doing them one or two times per month at an estimated cost of \$500-\$1000.

ANDRES told me that after he had smoked Crack Cocaine and had taken roughly two hits that he "wasn't himself". ANDRES said he began to think differently. He said he began to have bad thoughts about CHARLENE. He told us he thought about harming CHARLENE and then himself. ANDRES told us they began arguing regularly after smoking Crack Cocaine. ANDRES told us he didn't want to use Crack Cocaine at first but CHARLENE said to him if you love me you'd do it. "So I did," ANDRES told me the Crack Cocaine kept him high for hours. ANDRES told me when he crashed from the high he became angry and depressed. ANDRES said he didn't care if he was alive or not.

ANDRES said most of the fights were because he was working on and off. He had said that he had been working on and off for employment but was frustrated because his employment money would go completely for Crack Cocaine instead of being used on the family which meant a lot to him. ANDRES said CHARLENE wanted him to work and help her out more. ANDRES said the problem was all the money went to drugs so why should I work. ANDRES told me he was so mad and angry he wanted her kids to know what was going on.

ANDRES claimed he stopped using drugs for two months. ANDRES told us he was getting mad at CHARLENE because there was no food for the kids. ANDRES said CHARLENE would disappear for three or four days leaving the kids alone. ANDRES said he would stay with the kids and watch out for them. He also told me the kids got letters from their birth dad from prison who would tell them how to kill him by poisoning his food. ANDRES said the problem is "I'm completely in love with her." He also advised me that he was in his forties and that he had spent most of his life in prison and that he wanted to "go to church" and he wanted to have a family that he could take care of and take pride in. He said he had been kicked out of the house and that he had lived in several different places including his grandpa's place, a friend's, or he had slept in a car.

ANDRES stated that they had gotten hooked up using the Crack Cocaine with a friend of theirs. ANDRES told me he was fighting a war in his mind and the war assigned his body because he was fighting CHARLENE. He also said that he had told his probation agent, DON STEFANCIC, that he needed help and was willing to pay for it and that he had attended some AODA Classes. He also stated that he wanted CHARLENE to get some treatment because he felt that she had a drug problem and that she had routinely broke her promise two or three times a week to him.

ANDRES acknowledged that things had escalated in the past two months and that on October 3rd that they blew up at each other and that he had been placed in jail until the 4th of October. He said CHARLENE and he have had good times together; the best would be when they were going to the trailer at SCHINDLER's where we located him today. He stated when they walked into that trailer that nothing else seemed to matter, past or present, and that they got along.

ANDRES acknowledged from the incident that occurred on October 3rd that there was a Court Ordered No Contact Provision for him and CHARLENE to have contact. ANDRES told me they both had routinely broken this No Contact Order. ANDRES told me of frustrations that he could not talk to people about, CHARLENE's drug problem and that he didn't wish to get her in trouble because he loved her with all of his heart. He told me of repeated times where he had angry thoughts of harming CHARLENE building up within him from frustration. He did state that the

prescribed to him by [REDACTED] was because he suffered [REDACTED] and had been using it as needed for approximately a year and took the medication as he needed it but not necessarily daily.

ANDRES stated he felt he couldn't talk to anyone because of the sensitivity of the relationship. ANDRES told me every time somebody talked negative to me "it just fills me up into anger." ANDRES told me he wanted to let his anger out but didn't talk to anyone because he didn't want anyone to laugh at him. On the Friday night prior to the incident he said that he had actually taken the car and slept in the car and on Saturday he went to talk to JOSH and that CHARLENE had come home in a Dodge truck. ANDRES said that all he wanted was his personal property (rings worth \$1000's of dollars). ANDRES said he tried to stay calm but felt anger was building up in him and that he could feel himself getting mad and had walked into the pantry to get away from CHARLENE when she started yelling at him. ANDRES said they broke up as CHARLENE was dating the Crack Cocaine dealer. ANDRES said he felt the dealer was going to ruin CHARLENE's life. ANDRES said he was also seeing a female CHARLENE hated. ANDRES said during the argument he told CHARLENE about the female because he was angry. This made CHARLENE angrier. ANDRES told me she was in his personal zone face to face. ANDRES said he didn't walk into the pantry for the hatchet but he saw the hatchet and picked it up and swung it at her as she faced him. ANDRES told me he remembered her falling after swinging the hatchet. ANDRES said he wasn't sure how many times he swung the hatchet. He said that he admitted to taking one or two swings at CHARLENE, see confession attached to report. ANDRES also acknowledges that the kids tried to grab him while he was swinging and he didn't hear anything that they necessarily said. He was asked if he recalled necessarily hitting an animal and he did acknowledge that he could have hit an animal. The interview ended at 1315hrs. / Off the record.

ANDRES was questioned if he would assist the Police Department in providing us a name of the drug dealer that he knew. ANDRES stated that he was concerned about his son because the drug dealer had a picture of his son and knew his son. ANDRES thought the drug dealer may possibly kill his son. ANDRES said he wasn't necessarily so concerned for his own well-being. He did acknowledge a drug dealer that was coming up from Milwaukee who traded stolen car stereo equipment for Crack Cocaine. He also said stated that the main supplier that he had been in the home and had actually seen \$30,000.00 on a table with pounds of Cocaine and pounds of Marijuana in the home, which "made him scared". ANDRES stated that the main drug dealer that he didn't feel police could touch him. He stated that the main drug dealer was from San Diego. He also stated that there was a JASON who worked as a sub-contractor for Burger Boat that could lead law enforcement directly to the main king pin drug dealer. He stated that when drugs were transported from St Louis to Manitowoc that they were then, like a distribution center, from Manitowoc to a small town, possibly Whitelaw, where the drugs were distributed to this region or area.

ANDRES also makes reference to a home which was located only several houses from his house at 1905 Franklin Street Manitowoc which also had a person that was moving drugs from it. He also stated that law enforcement had been watching the home and that the person had been moving the drugs in the home doesn't necessarily care that law enforcement is sitting out there because he didn't feel there is anything they could do about it. ANDRES said that the drug dealers are extremely dangerous and that they are carrying firearms. He also made mention to seeing a nickel-plated firearm that was flashed in his direction one time when he saw CHARLENE inside the house actually using Crack Cocaine. He also made mention that when they made a drug run with drugs coming from St Louis that there were

several cars that would follow the main hauling vehicle and that if the vehicle would be detained that the other vehicles would have no problems in killing the party that would be detaining that vehicle, potentially law enforcement.

ANDRES MARTINEZ was advised of his charges and he was informed that he was being charged with ATTEMPTED FIRST DEGREE HOMICIDE, INTIMIDATION OF A VICTIM, ENDANGERING SAFETY BY USE OF A DANGEROUS WEAPON, MISTREATING ANIMALS, PHYSICAL ABUSE OF A CHILD, and BAIL JUMPING. He was photographed and fingerprinted. He was handcuffed; the handcuffs were placed in the handcuff groove checked for tightness and double-locked. He was escorted to Squad #57 and placed in the Secure Area of Squad #57. He was transported to MTSO. He was turned over to Correctional Personnel at MTSO. A copy of his PR Bail Bond is attached to the report for the Bail Jumping charge; see copy attached to the report.

The following is a summary of the persons, places, times and conversations / results of my portion of this investigation. My full addition to the report will be completed on Monday Nov. 7th at 2300 hours. See copy of attached blue sheet for information on persons I either spoke to or who are tied into this investigation.

Report for duty at 0245 hours. Assigned with Officer Garber to try and locate suspect Martinez.

Assist Sgt. Leist and Officer Garber in attempting to locate Martinez at Tara Novaks home at 3315 Yorkshire Ln # 16. Current renter advised Tara moved out last week.

At about 1530 hours, go with Officers Leist, Weyer and Garber to 3910 Waldo Blvd #35 (residence of Carlos Lopez and Bri Harrison – as I knew from prior calls that Martinez hangs out there. We had no contact at the residence. I went next door to trailer #36. as Bri's parents, Kim and Gary Harrison, live there and usually keep a close eye on trailer 35, as Carlos has a habit of beating up Bri. They were not home either. The doors and windows of trailer #35 (Lopez trailer) was not specifically checked – but later in the shift at 1738 hours, Lopez reported a burglary at his trailer where \$2300 cash was stolen and suspect entered through an east side window which was ajar, and screen cut. (2005-12628) When this call came in, I went to the call with Officer Schaefer to speak to Lopez. More specifics on that are further down this page.

Next, at about 1600 hours, Officers Leist, Weyer, Garber and I went to 1708 Meadowbrook Dr. apt. #106. Sgt. Leist had obtained info from another officer that Charlene's current boyfriend was Jason Ross, and we wanted to see what he knew and also check to make sure he was safe. Officer Garber and I went inside, while other officers covered the exterior of the building. We first made contact with building manager Laura DeWane and her daughter, Donna Pritzl, who also happens to work with Charlene at Rivers Bend. They were already aware of the assault against Charlene, and they had tried to contact Ross themselves to make sure he was alright. Knocking on the door, there was no answer. Given the circumstances, I had DeWane use her pass key to open the apt. so we could make sure Ross was OK. He was in the apt. He said he had not wanted to open the door. He informed us that when Charlene got off work at 0600 on Friday morning, she had been at his apt. up until about 1330 on 11-05. He said at about 2100 hours on 11-04, Martinez had come to his apt., pounding on the door and telling him to have Charlene come out, as he knew she was in there (which she was). Ross said Martinez said he had followed her there. Ross talked to Martinez through the door and told him she was not there. Ross said Martinez then went by his outer patio door, tried that for a short time and then left. At about 0730 on 11-05, Ross was going to use Charlene's car to run errands, but it was gone. They figured Martinez had stolen it from the Meadowbrook complex. Ross said Charlene was going to report it stolen, but did not want to report that it had been stolen from the Meadowbrook complex, as she did not want Ross to be involved. Ross said Charlene had said she would wait to report it stolen and claim it was stolen from her Franklin St. address. Ross said at between 1300 to 1330

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hours, Charlene got a call from her [redacted] [redacted] said Charlene's [redacted] had been involved in an accident and needed to go to the hospital. Ross said [redacted] drove over and picked up Charlene and took her back to Franklin St. Ross also said he had received a phone call from Charlene a short time before we arrived and was told that it had been Charlene's mother who had been hit by the axe. Ross was under the impression that Charlene was OK. We told him what had happened and watch his back. Pritzl also had suggested I speak to Charlene's good friend whom she works with at River Bend - Jennifer Skrove - Huycke.

Next at 1653 hours, I assisted Leist, Garber and Weyer making contact with James Nettles at 3703 S. 10th. He allowed officers to search the home. Martinez not located. Nettles told me he had last seen his dad at about noon. He said Martinez had driven him to Avery to pick up his vehicle which had been towed there earlier in the week. He said they could not get to Avery's as the place was crawling with deputies and they were not allowed to go in. He said his dad dropped him off at about noon when they returned to town.

At 1733, Weyer, Garber and I went to Victor Cota's residence. Ross had told me that he works with Victor and knows Victor's best friend was Martinez kid (James Nettles). Ross said maybe Martinez is with Cota. Cota said he had heard about the whole incident on the news. He said Martinez was not at his home. Cota's father (didn't get his name) was also present, so I didn't ask to search the house.

At 0537, dispatch told me about the burglary to Lopez trailer, and they were going to assign Officer Schaefer to it. I went along to Lopez home with Schaefer to see what Lopez had to say and find out where he had been. Lopez claimed the suspect had entered his trailer through his kitchen window, which was now ajar and the screen was cut. I was at Lopez residence on 10-27 and 11-04 for family trouble calls. On both instances, I noticed this window was ajar. Lopez told me he had been at an auction on hwy. 310 with Bri, his mother and Cota. He said they got there about 1300 hours and got home about 1700 hours. He noticed the screen cut and called dispatch at 1737 hours. He told me Martinez had been to his trailer the night before. Lopez and Bri told me that they heard about Charlene, and they were glad we had Martinez in custody. (We didn't) I asked them where they had heard we had him in custody and Lopez said from Cota's mother had called Lopez mother, who relayed that info to them. I wanted to speak to Lopez further but then Officer Weyer showed up and took me aside. Weyer told me a tip was received that Martinez was at Van's bar. I left Lopez trailer and assisted Garber and Weyer at Van's and Martinez was not located. Officer Schaefer continued her investigation at Lopez trailer. Weyer developed information that Martinez may be at TJ's tavern. We went there and Martinez was not located. I spoke to Swetlik and Habeck and told them I thought Lopez burglary stunk to high heaven and he should be questioned further. They went there and we were about to speak to Lopez again and I got a phone call from Linda Czekala. Swetlik, Habeck and Schaefer did speak to Lopez further but I was not present, as I was in the squad speaking to Linda.

Linda told me that last week, Joey Golden had dropped off a Ford Bronco (1984?) at her home, and told her she could have it. Joey said he had bought the vehicle from a friend who was going to prison for \$250.00, but had no use for it as he does not have a license. Linda told me that her daughter, Heather Kraemer, has a [redacted] year old [redacted] with Joey but the two are not together any longer. Heather also works with Charlene at River Bend. Linda said she had come to find out from her daughter that this Ford had been or actually was, still owned by Martinez. She was now scared Martinez would show up at her home to get the vehicle. She said the vehicle had WIRP temp plate AF2836 on it. I asked her to get a VIN number and she checked and said the VIN plate was removed from the dash and the sticker on the door frame was too worn and unreadable. Linda thought Joey lived in the 1900 block of Washington St. Meanwhile, Weyer had found out the clerk at Heritage Inn believed Martinez had been in earlier in the afternoon to inquire about renting a room, but didn't when he learned what the price was. Weyer and I checked Golddiggers Tavern for Martinez, but he was not located. Dispatch advised Golden's last known address was 1916A Washington St. Because this was close to the crime scene, we checked it. There was mail in the mail box for Golden. There was a TV on in the apt., but no answer to the door.

By this time, it was 2115 hours, and I went to River Bend and spoke to Jennifer Skrove-Huycke, who is Charlene's friend and supervisor, and I also spoke to Heather Kraemer. Jennifer told me Charlene has confided to her about the regular beatings Charlene gets from Martinez. She said about three weeks ago, Charlene had told her that Martinez had beat her and she called police and Martinez was arrested for a DVO. Jennifer said Charlene believed Martinez' PO would hold him in jail but Martinez was not held in jail. (Apparently that's when the injunction came into effect and Martinez was no longer supposed to live with Charlene or have contact with her.) Jennifer said after Martinez got out of jail, Charlene came to work with more and more [redacted] on her. Jennifer said Charlene told her last weekend that Martinez had told Charlene that he could handle them no being together, but if he found out she was cheating on him he would "bury us both." Jennifer said she believed Martinez used the black Ford Bronco (now at Linda Czekala's home) as she had seen him driving it. Jennifer said Martinez has come to River Bend on more than one occasion to check up on Charlene. Jennifer said the facility was currently under a lock down and would be for awhile, as they feared Martinez may come there. Jennifer said she guessed Faye Martinez would be the person hiding Martinez.

At 2136 hours, I interviewed Heather Kraemer, she told me that it was a possibility that Martinez could be with Joey Golden. She said Joey was now living with his [redacted] girlfriend named Teresa in Whitelaw. She did not know Teresa's last name, but a girl named Jenna Johnsrud would know that. Jenna was a former DARE student of mine so I knew who she was. Heather told me that she knew the Ford Bronco belonged to Martinez and she said that Joey and Martinez regularly made crack runs to Milwaukee in that vehicle to buy drugs. Heather told me that from what she knew, Martinez had a girlfriend named Tara Novak, who was [redacted] by him. She said she lived with her mother Donna who runs a group home on Huron St. Heather said Martinez and Tara are "crack buddies." Heather also told me she believed Martinez may be hiding out in Milwaukee with Charlene's daughter Amanda and her husband Freddie. Heather also told

me that when Charlene and Martinez were no longer living together, that Charlene had told her that Martinez was staying with Carlos Lopez. Charlene had also told Heather that Martinez made the statement to Charlene that he would kill her if he found out she was cheating on him.

Donna told Habeck Tara was in Peshtigo at a treatment center and she was pregnant by Abraham Arriaga. Officer Block told me that Lopez had showed up at the crime scene. Officer Block said Lopez was there while it was still light outside. Sunset is about 4:40 PM.

I called Jenna Johnsrud and learned that her friend Teresa Hanson is the person who lives with Joey Golden. Teresa and Joey also live with Teresa's parents, Debora and Kevin, Hanson. (Deb Hanson is one of the assistant coroners.) This info was passed on to MTSO to check the Whitelaw address for Martinez. Lt. Rocklewitz informed me on 11-06, that MTSO checked this address and they were told Martinez has never been to that house.

It's my belief that Lopez knows or possibly even transported Martinez to some unknown location.



[redacted] said [redacted] ran at Martinez, & Martinez pushed [redacted] back w/ one hand & swung hatchet at [redacted] said when [redacted] was pushed, it knocked [redacted] down to the floor & the hatchet missed [redacted] by about 2 inches. [redacted] also tried to help & Martinez pushed [redacted] in the left shoulder, knocking [redacted] down to the floor. [redacted] told me [redacted] had seen the hatchet last in the garage on top of an old entertainment center about 2 weeks ago. [redacted] was in the kitchen pantry this last Monday, but did not see the hatchet in there. A pitbull dog, owned by Hue Lee, was in the house & began running toward Martinez. Charlene, [redacted] & [redacted] all thought the dog was trying to defend Charlene. Martinez struck the dog on the top of the head w/ the hatchet, cutting the top of the dog's head. Martinez is currently out on bail for a Battery/DVO charge against Charlene from 10-03-05. As a condition of bail, Martinez is to have no contact w/ Charlene Edwards. Charlene did tell me that in the past months, she has had contact w/ Martinez w/ her going to where he is staying or he stops by her work. During those conversations, Martinez has been asking her to drop the battery charges.

The undersigned complainant, being first duly sworn, states that:

Count 1: ATTEMPT FIRST DEGREE INTENTIONAL HOMICIDE

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, November 05, 2005, in the City of Manitowoc, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, attempted to cause the death of Charlene M Edwards, with intent to kill that person, contrary to sec. 940.01(1)(a), 939.50(3)(a), 939.32 Wis. Stats., an attempt to commit a Class B Felony, and upon conviction may be sentenced a term of imprisonment not to exceed sixty (60) years.

Count 2: SECOND DEGREE RECKLESS ENDANGERMENT

The complainant further alleges he is informed by the reports of Michael Stone, known to the complainant to be an officer with the Manitowoc City Police Department that on November 5, 2005 at 1:37 p.m., he heard a dispatch assign Sgt. Flemal and Officer Hyler to an EMS call at Ancient Rites, 1910 Franklin Street, City of Manitowoc, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin reference a woman who had been struck in the _____ with an ax. Officer Stone heard Sgt. Flemal radio that the suspect was last seen running EB on Franklin Street.

The complainant further alleges upon Officer Stone's arrival in the area, Sgt. Flemal requested that another officer to assist him in clearing the residence of 1905 Franklin Street, as the suspect might possibly be inside, and this would be the residence where the attack occurred. Officer Stone met Sgt. Flemal at 1905 Franklin Street and they cleared the residence, locating nobody inside. Sgt. Flemal and Officer Stone cleared the detached garage, and nobody was inside the garage either. As officers were clearing the house and got to the kitchen area, Officer Stone could see _____ and what appeared to be hair on the floor in front of the refrigerator. Officer Stone could also see several _____ spots on the floor in front of the stove.

The complainant further alleges that Officer Hyler came over by Sgt. Flemal and Officer Stone at 1905 Franklin Street. Officer Hyler had been at Ancient Rites and stated to Stone the victim is Charlene Edwards, and stated Charlene had been struck with a hatchet in the [redacted] and had a [redacted] on the [redacted] of her [redacted] area. Charlene was transported via Rescue Squad to Holy Family Memorial Medical Center (HFMMC). Officer Hyler checked the backyard and located a hatchet in the grass behind the house at 1905 Franklin Street, and Officer Hyler pointed it out to Officer Stone. The hatchet is 14" long, with a brown and red wood handle. The head of the hatchet is blue, and is 5" long and 3" at the widest point (sharpened end).

The complainant further alleges that Officer Stone spoke with [redacted] Charlene Edwards' [redacted] who was in front of his house. [redacted] said [redacted] had been with [redacted] cousin, and [redacted] got dropped off at [redacted] house at 1905 Franklin Street. Shortly after [redacted] got home, Andres Martinez came to the house and let himself inside. [redacted] said Andres has a key to the house. [redacted] said Andres had come to the house to write a note for Charlene. [redacted] said [redacted] had gone to pick up Charlene from work and they came home around 1:30 or 1:45 p.m. [redacted] was sitting in the kitchen, and Andres was in the kitchen with [redacted] when Charlene and [redacted] came home. [redacted] said Charlene walked into the kitchen and she saw Andres and told Andres she didn't want to see him anymore. [redacted] said Charlene told Andres she was seeing someone else and Andres called Charlene a "dirty fucking bitch." [redacted] said Charlene and Andres began arguing about the above listed Chevrolet Cavalier, as Andres says the car is his because he bought it, but the car is titled under Charlene's name. Andres was asking Charlene for the title, as the car was his, but Charlene refused to give the title to him. [redacted] said Andres became very upset with Charlene and began yelling at her that "you can die you fucking bitch," saying the next time he came over he would smash out all the windows on the house, said he'd burn down the house with the kids in it and told her, "I hope you burn in hell."

The complainant further alleges that [redacted] said Andres grabbed Charlene with both hands by the upper arm/shoulder area and threw her down to the floor, and Charlene landed on her back. Charlene then rolled over onto her stomach and Charlene began calling [redacted] for help. [redacted] was in the living room when this occurred. Upon seeing this, [redacted] ran at Andres to him to get him away from Charlene. [redacted] said Andres moved and pushed [redacted], causing [redacted] to fall on his back on the floor. [redacted] had come into the kitchen and tried pulling Charlene across the floor to get her out of the room, and Andres pushed [redacted] shoulder and this knocked [redacted] to the floor.

The complainant further alleges that [redacted] said Andres went into a pantry that was off the kitchen by the stove, and when he came back into the kitchen, he had a hatchet in his hand. [redacted] said the hatchet had red on the handle. [redacted] said [redacted] began cursing at Andres. [redacted] said Andres grabbed Charlene's left leg, while she was still lying on her stomach, and said "die dirty bitch" as he (Andres) brought the hatchet up in his right hand about to his head height, and struck Charlene with the hatchet in the [redacted] of her [redacted] of her [redacted]. [redacted] immediately saw "a [redacted]" and [redacted], and saw Charlene put her hand to the [redacted] of her [redacted], and then Charlene rolled onto her back. [redacted] said Charlene began saying, "I'm sorry, I'm sorry, leave me alone" and put her hands up as if to protect herself. [redacted] said that after Andres hit Charlene, [redacted] was about four feet from Andres swearing at him and telling Andres he had no right to do this to [redacted] mother and saying, "you don't give a fuck about her." [redacted] said Andres swung the hatchet at [redacted], missing [redacted] left arm by about two inches. [redacted] showed Officer Stone how much the hatchet missed [redacted] by holding [redacted] index and thumb apart about two inches. [redacted] said Andres moved the hatchet to his left hand and brought it way behind his head, near his back, and brought the

hatchet down as fast as he could and hit Charlene again. [redacted] was not sure if this swing struck Charlene or not.

The complainant further alleges he is informed by the reports of [redacted] said [redacted] and [redacted] were trying to help Charlene when a pitbull, owned by Hue Lee, came into the kitchen. [redacted] said the pitbull began going after Andres as if he was trying to defend Charlene, and Andres swung the hatchet at the pit bull, striking it in the head. When Andres was distracted by the pitbull, Charlene was able to get up on her feet, and she ran out the back door. Andres ran out the back door chasing Charlene, and [redacted] went out behind Andres. [redacted] saw Charlene running down the driveway (NB), and [redacted] heard Andres say, "See you later," then saw Andres run into the backyard, drop the hatchet and jump over a fence into the yard of 1901 Franklin Street and run EB.

The complainant further alleges he is informed by the reports of that as Officer Stone went into the Emergency room at HFFMC where Charlene was in, Officer Stone noticed she was lying on her stomach on the hospital gurney. Charlene had a large bandage to the [redacted] of her [redacted] and Officer Stone saw [redacted] on her face, neck and in her hair. Officer Stone could see a [redacted] that was [redacted] to the [redacted] of her [redacted] that was [redacted].

The complainant further alleges that Charlene stated she got done with work at 5:00 a.m. today and went to a friend's house after work. Charlene went on to say she had called [redacted] to pick her up and bring her home; and [redacted] and Hue picked. Charlene said when she got home and went in the kitchen Andres was there and told her not to be mad and said he wanted to talk; and she told him to leave. Charlene said it was [redacted] Andres and she in the kitchen. Charlene said Andres was mad because he knew she was at Ross's. When asked how Andres knew, Charlene said she told him. Charlene told Andres "I'm sorry Andres, but you have to leave."

The complainant further alleges that Charlene said she told Andres she was leaving with the kids to get something to eat and Andres said, "Okay." Charlene said they all began to walk out the back door, when Andres hit her in the [redacted] of the [redacted] and she fell down on her back on the kitchen floor. Charlene said she never had an "ax" in the pantry; that it was always in the garage. Charlene said after being hit with the hatchet the first time, Andres said, "This is what you get." Andres then struck Charlene three more times in the [redacted] while she was down on the floor. Officer Stone asked if Andres struck Charlene with the sharpened end or blunt end of the hatchet, and Charlene did not know.

The complainant further alleges that Charlene said [redacted] and [redacted] tried to stop Andres by grabbing the "ax," but were unsuccessful. Charlene said the pitbull came into the kitchen and Andres hit the dog in the head with the "ax." Officer Stone noticed a [redacted] on Charlene's [redacted] that appeared to me to be a defensive [redacted] and asked her about how she received the [redacted]. Charlene said she was lying on her back on the kitchen floor and had her arms covering her head (her arms were actually touching her head) to try to stop the "ax." Charlene believed the hatchet stuck her [redacted] at this time, which caused the [redacted]. Officer Stone asked Charlene why this happened, and Charlene said, "To kill me." Charlene said when Andres was charged with battery, that he told her he would kill her if she left him.




