I log in all the vehicles that come into the lot. The crushed vehicles are sold to Mushtin out of Manitowoc, Nooks out of Denmark, Nook's hauls the vehicles that <sup>we</sup> crushed.

On Thursday Steve and I went to the Menards in Manitowoc and we picked up trusses and insulation and a few odds and ends at 6:30am. we got back about 9:30 - 10:00 PM. Steve and I both went home.

I left for the cabin at 7:20 pm <sup>on Friday.</sup> That's when I saw the head lights behind me and called Steve on his cell 920-323-4038. My Nephew Brendon Dassetz road up north with me. We took the flat bed wrecker to haul up the trusses and insulation.

on Friday when I left Steve was at home, my Mom was home because they were coming up in the morning. I don't know if my sister was home.

During the week Monday through Friday I did not hear any gun shots. If there were any shots fired on my property I would have heard them.

Family and friends use my pit to sight in their guns. I have no idea how the girls car got into my storage shed.

A front end loader would be needed to put a car in <sup>any</sup> row, even a tow truck would have a very hard time.

The front end loader is kept in the red building or the blue building and the keys are left in it.

The red and blue building are locked at night, Steve <sup>CA</sup>
