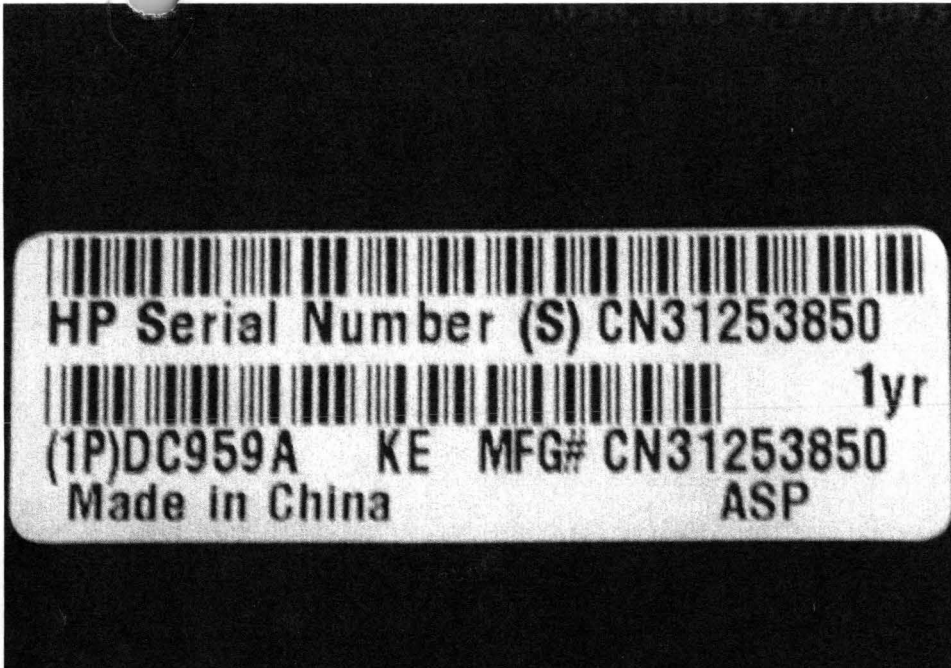

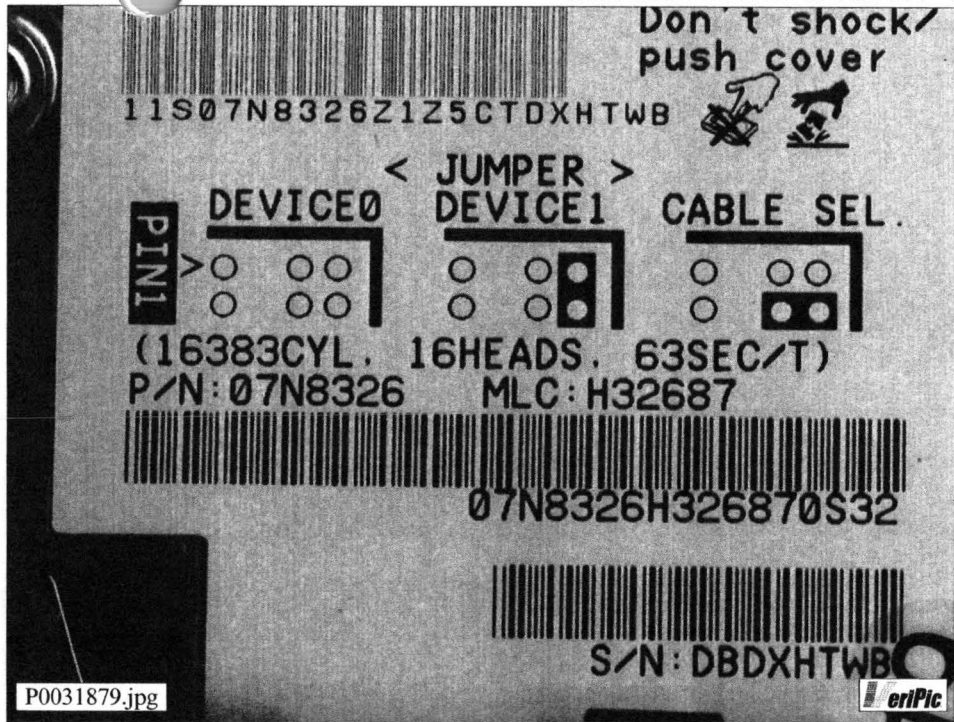

I, Detective Michael Velie #7727 was contacted by Investigator Wiegert of the Calumet County Sheriff's Dept. Inv. Wiegert indicated as part of his investigation they had obtained a computer tower from Steven Avery's residence. Inv. Wiegert indicated he was going to have an officer from the Calumet County Sheriff's Dept. deliver the computer to me at the Grand Chute Police Dept. and requested I do a forensic analysis on the computer.

On November 8, 2005 an officer with the Calumet County Sheriff's Dept delivered a Hewlett Packard Pavilion a802n, Serial #MXK5040MXH to me. Also delivered to me were several CD's, DVD's and some miscellaneous papers. I logged all these items into evidence and attached to this report is a copy of those evidence forms. At that time I photographed the computer both inside and out and removed the 200Gygabite hard drive from the Hewlett Packard Pavilion computer tower. I then acquired the 200Gygabite hard drive to evidence drive T-1000 using FTK Imager 2.1A. Upon completion of acquiring the 200GB hard drive I started a separate Encase case file and verified the acquisition. I then ran a signature and hash analysis and ran a recover folders feature within Encase. I then extracted all of the Internet history and created an Internet history report. I also ran an Internet and email search and analyzed the search results. A copy of the Internet history and email results will be turned over to Investigator Wiegert for his review. I then started an FTK case file and indexed the 200GB hard drive. Upon completion of indexing the drive I ran numerous key word searches within this hard drive and analyzed the search results. During my key word search I specifically focused the key word search on anything related to Theresa Halbach. Upon completion of analyzing any key word search results I extracted the user registry information and created a registry report. I also ran an initialized case Enscript and attached the copy of the results to the final report, which will be turned over to Investigator Wiegert. I also ran a file finder Enscript searching for images within this computer. I analyzed the search results and found numerous images that were consistent with standard Internet history. I also located pornography, which appeared to be digital camera pictures containing what

appeared to be Steven Avery and an adult female. These pictures appear to be dated back to July 2005. A copy of the pictures will be turned over to Investigator Wiegert for his review.

I also ran an initialized case Enscript within Mr. Avery's computer and attached the registry information as well as the time zone information to the final report. It should be noted it appeared as though Mr. Avery's time zone setting on his computer was set to Pacific Time or GMT minus eight hours. I will also be creating an archived copy of Mr. Avery's hard drive on DVD and will turn this over to Investigator Wiegert for any follow-up.

I, Detective Michael Velie #7727 was contacted by Investigator Wiegert with the Calumet County Sheriff's Dept. Investigator Wiegert indicated he was investigating a missing persons case and stated he had obtained a lap top computer and requested I do a forensic analysis on the computer.

On 11/05/05 at approx. 08:00 a.m. Investigator John Dederling of the Calumet County Sheriff's Dept delivered a Compaq Presario 2100 Lap Top computer, serial #CN31253850 to me at the Grand Chute Police Dept. At that time I photographed the lap top computer and logged the computer into evidence. Attached to this report is a copy of the Grand Chute Police Dept evidence form. I then removed and acquired 30Gygabite hard drive to Evidence drive T-1000 using FTK Imager Version 2.1A. Upon completion of acquiring the hard drive I started an Encase case file and verified the acquisition. I then ran a signature and hash analysis and extracted and began printing the email messages. I then started an FTK case file and started indexing the hard drive. All of the printed email messages were compiled and placed into a hardcover binder for Investigator Wiegert's review. Upon completion of indexing the hard drive I extracted and printed all of the address book information as well as email contact information. All this information was printed and will be turned over to Inv. Wiegert for his review.

I also searched for and extracted all of the Map Quest and Google Map HTML pages. I then placed all of these printed maps in order of creation date and will turn them over to Inv. Wiegert for his review. During my analysis I ran numerous key word searches and analyzed the results. All of the information that was extracted from this lap top computer was again printed and placed into hardcover binders and will be turned over to Inv. Wiegert for his review.

I also created an archive copy of the hard drive, which is copied to DVD and will be turned over to Inv. Wiegert for any necessary future follow-up.
