On Saturday, November 5, 2005, S/A Alan S. Hunsader was requested to assist with an investigation into the disappearance of Teresa Marie Halback, F/W, DOB [REDACTED]. At that time, S/A Hunsader was directed to the Avery property, located in the vicinity of 12930 Avery Rd., Town of Two Rivers, Manitowoc County, WI.

Upon speaking with investigators at that location, S/A Hunsader was advised that based on circumstances discovered in the vicinity at that location, a search effort was underway to determine if Halbach was present at that location. S/A Hunsader was further advised that a secondary location in the County of Marinette was also of interest at that as a possible location that Halbach may be at.

On Sunday, November 6, 2005, between the approximate times of 7:00 p.m., and 10p.m., S/A Hunsader and S/A Matthew D. Joy conducted surveillance of both the Manitowoc and Marinette locations. This surveillance was conducted from within an airplane flying over these locations. The Marinette location was identified by coordinates 45°:18'.88"N latitude, 88°:12'.775"W longitude; and the Manitowoc location was identified by coordinates 44°:15'.45"N latitude, and 87°:41'.40"W longitude. While flying over these locations, S/A Hunsader observed as the below lying terrain of the aforementioned location was scanned utilizing an infrared camera, a device designed to measure differences in heat patterns. As a result of this scan, nothing of evidentiary value was located. This scan was videotaped and this videotape D-7801-1 was retained as evidence by S/A Hunsader.

On Tuesday, November 8, 2005, S/A Hunsader again conducted aerial surveillance over the Avery location and surrounding locations in Manitowoc County. While over this vicinity, S/A Hunsader again conducted visual surveillance, as well as thermal and photographic imagery of that location. While in the vicinity of that location, S/A Hunsader was directed by SAIC Peter M. Thelen to pay specific attention to the area, located at 44°:15'.292"N latitude, 87°:41'.532"W longitude. Based on the aforementioned, S/A Hunsader was subsequently directed into an area, located near to the Avery residence and adjacent to the vehicle junkyard. Nothing of immediate evidentiary value was noted from the aerial platform; however, this area was examined with photo looking infrared visually and photographed. An area that appeared to be a black burned-out portion of the property was noted in the immediate vicinity of the Avery residence.

It should be noted that while in the vicinity of this location, the entire area and surrounding areas were examined visually and through photographic and infrared imagery. During this surveillance, areas of interest were examined by ground crews, nothing of evidentiary value was located. S/A Hunsader videotaped the aforementioned infrared scans. These tapes are preserved in evidence as tapes D-7801-2 and 3.
