On Thursday, 11/10/2005, at approximately 9:00 p.m., while at STEVEN A. AVERY SR.'s (DOB: [REDACTED] property, 12932 Avery Road, Two Rivers, Wisconsin, S/A Lisa A. Wilson provided S/A James C. Holmes with evidentiary items that were collected from BRYAN J. DASSEY (DOB: [REDACTED] earlier in the day on 11/10/2005. The items were listed on DCI property receipts numbered D7709 and D7710. S/A Wilson provided S/A Holmes with the following evidentiary items for transport to the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory in Madison, Wisconsin for comparative purposes:

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
