On November 12, 2005, S/A Kevin L. Heimerl assisted with the investigation of the missing person Teresa Marie Halbach in the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, WI. S/A Heimerl conducted a neighborhood canvas of the area surrounding STH 147 and Avery Road.

On November 12, 2005, at 8:15 a.m., S/A Heimerl made personal contact with two individuals identified as [REDACTED], W/M, DOB [REDACTED], who resides at [REDACTED], Two Rivers, [REDACTED]. Also contacted was [REDACTED] daughter, [REDACTED], W/F, DOB [REDACTED], who resides at the same address. Also residing at the same address and not contacted was [REDACTED], W/F, DOB [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] residence is located [REDACTED] Avery Road.

S/A Heimerl asked [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] if they have seen recent media coverage concerning the missing female and her vehicle from Calumet County. Both stated that they were familiar with the investigation and had seen pictures of the missing female and her vehicle. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated that they had not seen the missing female or her vehicle in the area.

[REDACTED] stated that on the previous Friday, 11/04/2005, he left work and went directly to his property where he has another residence near Crivitz, WI, and ultimately spent the entire weekend there. [REDACTED] stated he returned to his residence on Monday, 11/07/2005, at approximately 5:00 p.m. [REDACTED] stated his wife, [REDACTED], works during the week in Crivitz and she, as well, spent the weekend at their property in Crivitz.

[REDACTED] stated that she works in DePere, WI, and on Friday, 11/04/2005, she flew directly out of the Green Bay airport and flew out of state to visit her boyfriend. She returned to the area on Monday evening, 11/07/2005, at approximately 11:30 p.m.

S/A Heimerl inquired as to whether or not [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] recalled seeing anything out of the ordinary or abnormal in the area during the first week of November, 2005, and they stated they had not. S/A Heimerl asked if the [REDACTED] were familiar with the Avery business or the Avery family. [REDACTED] stated she is familiar with the Avery family, and she went to school with Corey Avery, who is now deceased.

The [REDACTED] were unable to provide any further information.
