On November 12, 2005, S/A Kevin L. Heimerl assisted with the investigation of the missing person Teresa Marie Halbach in the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, WI. S/A Heimerl conducted a neighborhood canvas of the area surrounding STH 147 and Avery Road.

On November 12, 2005, at 8:25 a.m., S/A Heimerl made personal contact with two individuals identified as [REDACTED] W/M, DOB [REDACTED] and his wife, [REDACTED] W/F, DOB [REDACTED], who reside at [REDACTED], Two Rivers, [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] residence is located [REDACTED] STH 147.

S/A Heimerl inquired as to whether or not the [REDACTED] have seen recent media coverage concerning the missing female and her vehicle from Calumet County. The [REDACTED] stated that they had seen the media coverage and had seen pictures of the missing female and her vehicle. The [REDACTED]s stated they had not seen the missing female or her vehicle in the area.

S/A Heimerl inquired as to whether or not the [REDACTED] had made any observations of unusual or abnormal activity in their neighborhood during the course of the previous week. The [REDACTED] stated they had not seen anything unusual during that time. [REDACTED] stated that on 10/31/2005, at approximately 4:45 p.m., she was returning home from work to her residence and drove along STH 147 past Avery Road. She stated at that time she did not observe anything unusual, however, she stated she was not looking for anything unusual at the time.

S/A Heimerl inquired as to whether or not the [REDACTED] were familiar with the Avery business or the Avery family, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated he has resided at this location for approximately 36 years. He stated he is familiar with the Avery family. He stated also that he is aware that this father, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who resides at [REDACTED], had gone to the Avery salvage business approximately 3 weeks earlier to purchase a used car battery. [REDACTED] stated he has not had any recent contact with the Avery family or the Avery business.

The [REDACTED] were unable to provide any further information.
