On November 7, 2005, S/A Kevin L. Heimerl and S/A James A. Sielehr assisted with the investigation of the missing person, Teresa Marie Halbach, in the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, WI. S/A Heimerl and S/A Sielehr conducted a neighborhood canvas of the area surrounding STH 147 and Avery Rd.

On November 7, 2005, at approximately 8:15 a.m., S/A Heimerl and S/A Sielehr made personal contact with Debbie S. Hagenow, F/W, DOB 12/13/1971, who resides at 13008 Jambo Creek Rd., Two Rivers, WI, 920-755-3102. Hagenow resides at this residence with her husband, Todd Hagenow. Debbie Hagenow stated she and her husband have resided at this residence for approximately six years.

Investigators asked Hagenow if she had seen media coverage of the missing female in Manitowoc County. Hagenow stated that she had seen the media coverage. Hagenow stated that she had seen pictures of the missing female, however, she had not seen pictures of the missing vehicle. Hagenow stated that she is home at her residence all day long with her small children. The investigators asked if she had seen the missing female in the area. Hagenow stated that she had not. Investigators asked Hagenow if she had made any observations during the previous week of any unusual activity or anything she felt may potentially be related to this investigation. Hagenow stated that she had not made any observations, which she felt were unusual or related to the investigation. Investigators asked if Hagenow or her husband were familiar with the Avery family or their business. Hagenow stated that she and her husband did business with the Avery Salvage Yard approximately two months previous. Hagenow was unable to provide any further information.
