On November 7, 2005, S/A Kevin L. Heimerl and S/A James A. Sielehr assisted with the investigation of the missing person, Teresa Marie Halbach, in the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, WI. S/A Heimerl and S/A Sielehr conducted a neighborhood canvas of the area surrounding STH 147 and Avery Rd.

On November 7, 2005, at approximately 1:45 p.m., S/A Heimerl and S/A Sielehr made personal contact with a subject identified as Joshua K Sasse, M/W, DOB 01/12/1975, who resides at 4130 Kuss Rd., Two Rivers, WI, 920-755-3263.

Sasse resides at this residence with his wife, Brenda Sasse, who was not present for the interview.

Investigators asked Sasse if he had seen recent media coverage concerning the missing female from Calumet County. Sasse stated that he had seen that media coverage. Investigators asked Sasse if he had seen pictures of the missing female and her vehicle and Sasse stated that he has see the pictures, but he has not seen the female or her vehicle in the area. Investigators asked Sasse if he has made any observations of any unusual activity or any activity he felt was potentially related to the investigation and Sasse stated that he has not. Sasse stated that he owns approximately five acres surrounding his residence. Sasse stated that he has walked through his property several times since learning of the investigation and has found nothing unusual.

Sasse was asked if he was familiar with the Avery family or the Avery business. Sasse stated that he is not familiar with the business or the Avery family. Sasse stated that he was aware after speaking with his neighbor, Leo Richmond, that Richmond had had a young lady come to his door late in the evening on Friday, November 4, 2005. Sasse had no further information concerning that incident. Sasse was unable to provide any further information.
