On November 14, 2005, S/A Kevin L. Heimerl and Calumet County Sheriff's Department Investigator John Dederling continued follow-up investigation regarding the homicide investigation of Teresa Marie Halbach, in the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, WI.

On 11/14/2005, at 2:35 p.m., S/A Heimerl and Investigator Dederling returned to the [REDACTED] residence at [REDACTED], Two Rivers, WI. S/A Heimerl and Investigator Dederling returned to the residence to recontact [REDACTED] W/M, DOB [REDACTED] and any of his children, to determine if they had additional information concerning the identity of a female who had been looking for the [REDACTED] residence at approximately midnight on 11/04/2005. This unknown female had stopped at the [REDACTED] residence at [REDACTED], Two Rivers, and expressed an interest in locating the [REDACTED] residence.

After arriving at the [REDACTED] residence, investigators met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that his son, [REDACTED] was present at the residence and investigators ultimately met with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Investigators again asked [REDACTED] if he had determined who the female was who may have stopped at the [REDACTED] residence late in the evening on Friday, 11/04/2005. [REDACTED] provided the following information:

[REDACTED] stated that on Friday evening, 11/04/2005, he was at his cousin, [REDACTED] residence on [REDACTED]. He stated at approximately 9:45 p.m., himself, his brother, [REDACTED] and his cousin, [REDACTED] walked from [REDACTED] residence back to [REDACTED] residence on [REDACTED] Road. [REDACTED] stated, after arriving at his residence, he found additional subjects at his residence, to include his sister, [REDACTED] and her friend [REDACTED], last name unknown, as well as a classmate of [REDACTED] who he identified as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he ultimately spent the entire evening at his residence, however, he stated he went to sleep earlier than the others. He stated that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stayed up later in the evening. [REDACTED] stated the following morning he learned that sometime after midnight, [REDACTED] sister came to the residence to pick [REDACTED] up.

[REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated he is aware that [REDACTED] attends school at the Mishicot School District. Investigators departed the [REDACTED] residence and attempted to locate additional information concerning [REDACTED] and his older sister.
