On Thursday, 11/10/2005, at approximately 8:45 p.m., while at STEVEN A. AVERY SR.'s (DOB: 07/09/1962) property, Calumet County Sheriff's Deputy Rick Riemer provided S/A James C. Holmes with the following evidentiary items that law enforcement officers had collected in or around a burn pit located near a mobile home trailer and garage belonging to STEVEN AVERY:

S/A Holmes placed the above-mentioned evidentiary items into his state assigned vehicle and transported the items to the DCI headquarters office in Madison, Wisconsin. On 11/10/2005, at approximately 11:30 p.m., Director Robbie Lowery met S/A Holmes at DCI headquarters and assisted S/A Holmes with securing the above-mentioned evidentiary items in DCI's property room.

On 11/11/2005, S/A Holmes obtained the above-mentioned items from DCI's property room for transport to the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory. At 11:42 a.m., S/A Holmes submitted all above-mentioned items, except the dog stool (#D6266(8), Calumet County Sheriff ID #7937) to Evidence Technician Delores Larson at the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory. During the afternoon of 11/11/2005, S/A Holmes returned the dog stool to the DCI headquarters' property room. S/A Holmes placed the dog stool in a metal quart can, which he sealed with evidence tape.

Copies of DCI property receipts #D6266 and #D6267 will be included in the case file. Copies of the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory's 'Receipt of Physical Evidence' form and the

Calumet County Sheriff's Department's 'Evidence/Property Custody Document' that pertained to the aforementioned evidentiary items will also be included in the case file.
