On Wednesday, November 16, 2005, at approximately 9:53 a.m., S/A Thomas A. Sturdivant spoke with Jack Eis regarding the Steven Avery investigation. S/A Sturdivant advised Eis that S/A Sturdivant had located a business document regarding a transaction that took place at Avery Auto Salvage on 11/02/2005, and was seeking information regarding that transaction.
