On Tuesday, November 15, 2005, at approximately 2:25 p.m., S/A Thomas A. Sturdivant made contact with Charles G. Phillips (Charlie), W/M, DOB 03/12/1954, and his wife, Laura N. Phillips, W/F, DOB 11/05/1960, at their residence located at 401 S. State Street, Mishicot, WI 54228. For the purpose of this report, once a subject is identified they will be referred to by their first name.

S/A Sturdivant explained to Charlie and Laura that S/A Sturdivant was assisting with the Teresa Halbach investigation and wanted to talk to them about a business record located at the Avery Auto Salvage office with their name on it. S/A Sturdivant explained to both Laura and Charlie that a receipt dated 11/04/2005 had been located at the Avery salvage yard office and made reference to a 1979 Chevrolet vehicle.

Charlie stated that he had called the Avery salvage yard on Thursday, 11/03/2005, between 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to bring their son's vehicle to the Avery salvage yard and have it junked. Charlie stated he had spoken with Chuck Avery during that phone call. Charlie stated that Chuck told him to bring the vehicle to the junkyard on Friday.

Charlie stated he and Laura arrived at the salvage yard on Friday, 11/04/2005, between 10:00 and 11:00 a.m. Charlie stated when they arrived at the office on 11/04/2005, they noticed that Steve Avery, Chuck Avery, and Earl Avery were all in the office, along with two other unidentified young boys.

Laura stated that she did observe Steve leave the office. Laura stated that, as she and Charlie were leaving the Avery junk yard, she saw Steve again and waved in a good-bye gesture to Steve, who responded in kind.

Charlie and Laura stated they also saw Steve, Earl and another unidentified gentleman standing around the home near the office, adjusting a television antenna.

Charlie stated that, while they were there, they were allowed to go into the salvage yard pit unescorted and also noticed another unidentified male walking around carrying a cup of coffee.

The interview with Charlie and Laura Phillips was concluded at 2:37 p.m.
