On Monday, November 14, 2005, at approximately 2:31 p.m., S/A Thomas A. Sturdivant made contact with Terry R. Sobel, W/M, DOB 12/18/1952, at his residence located at 7810 Manitou Road, Two Rivers, WI 54241, 920-683-3333.

S/A Sturdivant informed Sobel that S/A Sturdivant was conducting follow-up regarding the Teresa Halbach investigation. S/A Sturdivant advised Sobel that, during a search of the office at Avery Auto Salvage, a receipt was located dated 10/31/2005, regarding a 1984 Mazda, and S/A Sturdivant was interested in the details surrounding the transaction. For the purpose of this report, once the Averys are mentioned they will be referred to by their first name.

Sobel stated he owned a 1984 Mazda vehicle that he wanted to junk, and had contacted Chuck Avery on Friday, 10/28/2005, to arrange to have the vehicle picked up. Sobel stated he had arranged with the Avery salvage yard to pick up the vehicle on Monday, 10/31/2005, at the Point Beach State Park. Sobel stated he called Avery Auto Salvage again on the morning of 10/31/2005 to confirm the pick up. Sobel stated he spoke with Chuck during that conversation.

Sobel stated Earl Avery arrived on Monday, 10/31/2005, between 8:45 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. to pick up the vehicle at the Point Beach State Park. Sobel stated that Earl was alone at the time, and Sobel had given the vehicle to Avery Auto Salvage for free in lieu of them picking it up.

The interview was concluded at 2:45 p.m.
