On Tuesday, November 15, 2005, at approximately 10:20 a.m., S/A Thomas A. Sturdivant contacted Rick G. Royer, W/M, DOB 08/19/1954, who is the owner/operator of The Tune Up Shop, located at 612 N. Water Street, Manitowoc, WI 54220, 920-682-8085. The brief interview took place at the business.

S/A Sturdivant informed Royer that S/A Sturdivant was conducting follow-up investigation regarding the Teresa Halbach case. S/A Sturdivant advised Royer that, during a search of the office at Avery Auto Salvage, S/A Sturdivant had noticed a receipt bearing the name of The Tune Up Shop, dated 10/31/2005, regarding a 1991 Dodge, and S/A Sturdivant was interested in the details surrounding that transaction. For the purpose of this report, once the Averys are mentioned they will be referred to by their first name.

Royer stated he had called Avery Auto Salvage during the morning of 10/31/2005 and spoke with Chuck Avery about picking up a junked vehicle from The Tune Up Shop. Royer stated Earl Avery arrived at The Tune Up Shop sometime after lunch, or perhaps early afternoon, and removed the 1991 Dodge vehicle from the premises. Royer stated that Earl was driving the flatbed car hauler at the time.

The interview was concluded at 10:25 a.m.
