On Tuesday, November 15, 2005, at approximately 10:40 a.m., S/A Thomas A. Sturdivant arrived at the residence of Jennifer J. Johnsrud, W/F, DOB 04/03/1985, located at 1140 N. 17th Street, Manitowoc, WI.

S/A Sturdivant advised Johnsrud that S/A Sturdivant was conducting follow-up investigation concerning the Teresa Halbach case. S/A Sturdivant further explained to Johnsrud that S/A Sturdivant had located a business receipt dated 11/02/2005, at the Avery Auto Salvage office, and was seeking further details regarding that transaction.

Johnsrud stated her grandfather, Neil Rezachek, had arranged with the Avery salvage yard to have her 1993 Ford vehicle junked. Therefore, Johnsrud called her grandfather via telephone to gather the details. Johnsrud was advised by her grandfather, Rezachek, that someone from the Avery Auto Salvage yard had picked up the vehicle at his residence, 1712 Daisy Lane, Shawano, WI 54241, around 2:30 p.m. on 11/02/2005. The Avery representative had paid Rezachek \$20 for the vehicle. Rezachek stated he could be contacted via his mobile phone, 920-323-6123, if S/A Sturdivant had further questions.
