On November 15, 2005, S/A Kevin L. Heimerl conducted follow-up investigation regarding the homicide investigation of Teresa Marie Halbach, in the Town of Gibson, Manitowoc County, WI. S/A Heimerl conducted follow-up investigation to attempt to identify a young female who had stopped at the second residence at the second residence at the second second

S/A Heimerl asked if she was in the area of or on the evening of  $11/0\overline{4/2005}$ , possibly to pick up her brother, stated she was in that area on that evening. stated that she recalled it was a Friday evening, approximately 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> weeks prior to the interview. stated on that evening, at approximately 11:30 to 11:45 p.m., she received a telephone call from her brother, indicating he needed a ride from the residence, as the person who was going gave her general to drive him home had to work late. stated that her brother, and explained to her that she needed to turn onto directions to and to look for a residence with basketball hoops and lights on at the residence. stated she drove to the area and ultimately drove down a road and was traveling down this road off of CTH Q when she saw a residence with lights on and also saw basketball hoops in the driveway. stated she pulled in the driveway and knocked on the front door and an adult male answered the door. She stated she recognized this adult male as being , and stated then stated she realized she had the wrong she knows from church. residence and then asked for directions to the residence. stated she was ultimately successful in reaching the residence and she and then returned home to their residence.

S/A Heimerl asked **sector** if she recalled what she was wearing for clothing on that evening. **Sector** stated she was probably wearing a red hooded sweatshirt. S/A Heimerl asked how she carries her car keys, and she stated her car keys are attached to a lanyard she described as being black in color.

Based on the information received from a concerning her admission that she stopped at the second residence during the late evening hours on 11/04/2005, S/A Heimerl is confident that second is the unknown female described by during his interview as part of the neighborhood canvas.
