On Wednesday, November 16, 2005, between the approximate hours of 1:05 pm and 1:15 pm, Special Agent Matthew D. Joy interviewed Josh R. Radandt at the hunting cabin located on Radandt's property located adjacent to the Avery Auto Salvage Yard.

The aforementioned interview was being conducted to clarify some of the information Radandt had provided in earlier interviews to law enforcement officers.

Radandt stated that on October 31, 2005, after being at the hunting cabin with Gregory A. Phillips, both he and Phillips left the cabin at approximately 6:00 pm.

Radant confirmed that the vehicles which had been moved around the area of a conveyor approximately one year ago had not been physically placed on the conveyor, but were located in the vicinity of the conveyor.

The interview was terminated at approximately 1:15 pm.
