On Monday, November 7, 2005, while at the Marinette County Sheriff's Department, S/A Kim J. Skorlinski received from Investigator Tony O'Neill a Memorex CD-R containing recorded interviews of Steven E. Avery, DOB 07/09/1962, on November 5 and 6, 2005; and of Brendan R. Dassey, DOB 10/19/1989, on November 6, 2005. These interviews were recorded by Inv. O'Neill on a digital recorder and then transferred to the CD.

Subsequently, S/A Skorlinski had additional copies of the CD made for investigative purposes and to use for the transcript at a later date.

On Thursday, November 17, 2005, S/A Skorlinski assigned DCI Property Receipt No. C-8457-1 to the CD containing the recorded interviews that was received from Inv. O'Neill. The CD will remain in evidence at the Appleton DCI office.
