On Friday, 11/11/2005, at approximately 4 p.m., S/A Lisa A. Wilson met Calumet County Investigator Mark Weigert and S/A Tom Fassbender at the off-ramp of Highway 10 West at Interstate 43 for the purpose of picking up evidence to bring to the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory (WSCL) in Madison, Wisconsin.

S/A Wilson obtained two items from Investigator Weigert. Both items were brown paper bags, sealed with evidence tape, each with an orange-colored evidence tag affixed. One orange tag was numbered 8730 with the description listed as a buccal swab taken from Timothy Halbach. The other orange tag was numbered 8731 with a description listed as a buccal swab from Karen Halbach. S/A Wilson signed the evidence transfer form provided by Investigator Weigert and took custody of the two items.

S/A Wilson transported these two evidentiary items directly to the WSCL, stopping only once in Rosendale, Wisconsin, for gas. S/A Wilson did not leave her car unattended while fueling up, paying at the pump for the gas.

S/A Wilson arrived at the WSCL at approximately 6:45 p.m. and met with Program Assistant Supervisor Barb Henning. S/A Wilson filled out a WSCL evidence transmittal form for the two evidentiary items and provided the two evidentiary items and the form to Henning. S/A Wilson also put her initials, "LAW," across the evidence tape on each bag.

Henning assigned the following WSCL case numbers to the evidence submitted:

The brown paper bag sealed with evidence tape, with the orange evidence sticker numbered 8730 affixed, buccal swab from Timothy Halbach, was assigned M05-2467 #CC.

The brown paper bag sealed with evidence tape and with the orange evidence sticker numbered 8731, buccal swab from Karen Halbach, was assigned M05-2467 #CD.

Henning provided S/A Wilson with a receipt of physical evidence for the items provided by S/A Wilson.
