On Tuesday, November 22, 2005, at approximately 10:45 a.m., S/A Kim J. Skorlinski received from S/A Thomas J. Fassbender evidence contained under DCI Property Receipt No. D-6263-1, a garage door opener from Teresa Halbach's vehicle; and D-6258-1, a pillbox containing charred material. The evidence was being transferred to S/A Skorlinski so he could transfer it to the Calumet County Sheriff's Department.

At approximately 12:00 p.m., S/A Skorlinski met with Investigator Mark Wiegert at the Calumet County Sheriff's Department and transferred to him the evidence contained under DCI Property Receipt No. D-6263-1 and D-6258-1.

Also, S/A Skorlinski transferred to Investigator Wiegert evidence contained under DCI Property Receipt No. C-8457-1, which was a Memorex CD-R containing recorded interviews of Steven Avery and Brendan Dassey; and C-8458-1 and 2, which were two receipts from the Intimate Treasures store, Manitowoc. All of this evidence will now be in the custody of the Calumet County Sheriff's Department.
