On Saturday, November 12, 2005, S/A Rodney J. Pevytoe, accompanied by S/A Ronald Ebben, conducted an examination of the contents of four 55-gallon barrels recovered from the Steven Avery property site. The barrels were identified with Calumet County property tags 642, 643, 644 and 645. An examination of the barrels 642, 644 and 645 failed to reveal any items of suspected evidentiary value. An examination of the barrel identified as 643 showed that its contents had numerous quantities of burned bone material. This bone material was collected in the presence of Deputy Rick Riemer, of the Calumet County Sheriff's Department, and preserved by him under Calumet County property tag 7964 for its potential evidentiary value.
