On Friday, November 11, 2005, at approximately 11:45 a.m., SAIC Peter M. Thelen entered the garage area of the residence of Allen and Delores Avery, located at 12930 Avery Road, Two Rivers, WI, for the purpose of searching Dorothy Avery's vehicle.

Upon entering the garage area through the service door, SAIC Thelen observed a golf cart parked next to Delores Avery's vehicle in the garage, which was going to be seized by investigators for the purposes of examination. Upon shining a flashlight upon the seat of the golf cart, SAIC Thelen observed hairs, which appeared to be pubic in nature, located on the left side of the seat of the golf cart.

At this time, SAIC Thelen attempted to search Dorothy Avery's vehicle, which was locked. SAIC Thelen then exited the garage and notified Evidence Technician Daniel Feucht, of the Grand Chute Police Department, of the hairs located on the seat of the golf cart. E/T Feucht advised he would collect the hairs and turn them over to the Calumet County Sheriff's Department as evidence.

On 12/02/2005, SAIC Thelen contacted John Ertl, at the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory, who advised SAIC Thelen that on 11/05/05 Ertl was following a cadaver dog around on the Avery property and that the dog hit on the cargo area or rear area of the golf cart. Ertl advised that he processed the cargo area of the cart but didn't process the rest of the cart and that the details of that examination are contained in a separate report done by Ertl.. This concluded SAIC Thelen's contact with Ertl.
