TERESA MARIE HALBACH: Photography and collection of quarry items

On November 9, 2005 at approximately 3:30 p.m., S/A Robert Powell assisted with the investigation of a missing person in the Manitowoc County's Town of Gibson. Upon arriving at incident command, S/A Powell received the following assignment:

During the week of October 31, 2005, authorities searched a quarry adjacent to Avery Auto Salvage. During the search, approximately 20 items were marked by searchers. The items consisted of ash piles, stone/rock piles, animal excrement piles, rifle cartridges, and personal items including a necklace and a small zippered pouch. The items were marked with small utility flags and a uniformed law enforcement officer stood by each item until the item was collected.

S/A Powell was assigned to photograph and collect the items that were determined to have evidentiary value. Once the items were collected, further analysis could proceed within a controlled environment. Expected precipitation dictated the need for collection versus analysis at the scene.

Assisting S/A Powell was S/A William Boswell, Officer Daniel A. Feucht of the Grand Chute Police Department and Deputy Nick Sablich of the Calumet County Sheriff's Department. In addition, Daniel A. Feucht is a Forensic Criminalist and the Director of the Criminal Justice Division for the Fox Valley Technical College in Appleton, WI.

As each item was collected, Deputy Sablich documented the item utilizing the evidence collection and documentation protocol for the Calumet County Sheriff's Department. Deputy Sablich identified each location utilizing a global positioning system (GPS) unit.

S/A Powell photographed each items utilizing a 35 mm auto focus SLR camera with three rolls of 24 exposed frames of 400 ISO color print film.
