On Wednesday, December 7, 2005, at approximately 1:00 p.m., while at the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Academy, Franklin, S/A Kim J. Skurlinski received from S/A Neil McGrath evidence listed on DCI Property Receipt No. D-6530, Items 1 and 2. This evidence consisted of two computer disks obtained from the Auto Trader magazine containing photographs of vehicles. The computer disk under Item 1 contained photos of vehicles under Steven Avery's account, #45860, and the computer disk under Item 2 contained photographs of vehicles under Tom Janda's account, #47810. This evidence was being transferred to S/A Skurlinski so he could transfer it to S/A Thomas J. Fassbender.

On Wednesday, December 14, 2005, at approximately 9:10 a.m., while at the Appleton DCI office, S/A Skurlinski transferred to S/A Fassbender this evidence contained under Property Receipt No. D-6530, Items 1 and 2. These items will remain in evidence at the Appleton DCI office.
