On Sunday, November 6, 2005, in the late afternoon or early evening while at the Avery salvage yard, 12930 Avery Road in the Town of Gibson, Wisconsin, S/A Thomas J. Fassbender had telephone contact with Crime Laboratory Analyst Steve Harrington. Analyst Harrington advised they had gained entry into Teresa Halbach's Toyota Rav4 vehicle. Analyst Harrington explained the Rav4 had been locked and they had to enlist the services of a locksmith to gain entry to the vehicle. Analyst Harrington advised that, upon entry to the vehicle, they did obtain a presumptive positive for the presence of blood in the front of the vehicle by the ignition and in back of the vehicle. Analyst Harrington advised they visually observed what appeared to be blood in the rear cargo area of the vehicle on the passenger side, and what appeared to impressions caused by hair in the blood. Analyst Harrington described the amount of blood in the rear portion of the vehicle as a "very visual amount." Analyst Harrington advised they also observed visible palm prints on the vehicle.

S/A Fassbender asked Analyst Harrington if they observed a phone or camera inside the vehicle and he advised no. S/A Fassbender asked if they observed any flash cards inside the vehicle and he advised not at that time. He advised, however, that they had not completed a search of the vehicle.
