On Monday, November 14, 2005, at approximately 9:31 a.m., Allan Avery telephoned S/A Thomas J. Fassbender on S/A Fassbender's cellular telephone. Allan Avery expressed concerns about business records that had been taken from his office, about his wife's sheets being taken, about car trunks being forced open and Chuck Avery's door being broken. He questioned why law enforcement officials could not go into Chuck Avery's backdoor.

S/A Fassbender discussed his concerns with him and advised that as much care and caution was taken during the execution of the search warrant on the Avery property. S/A Fassbender also told Allan Avery that he would be more than happy to make copies of his business records and return the copies to him. Ultimately, Allan Avery indicated that he understood and the contact was concluded at 9:38 a.m.
