On Friday, December 16, 2005, at approximately 9:15 a.m., while at the Appleton DCI office, S/A Kim J. Skorlinski received from Lieutenant Cheryl Eischen, of the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department, a copy of an incident report relating to Steven A. Avery, DOB 07/09/1963. Lt. Eischen queried Avery's name through the Winnebago County law enforcement database, and found one incident involving Avery.

The incident report was from the Town of Menasha Police Department, report #96-2499, dated 09/03/1996. The report indicates that Jennifer L. Janda, DOB 01/21/1972, came into the Town of Menasha Police Department to report that she was receiving mail from an ex-boyfriend, Avery, who was currently at the Fox Lake Correctional Institution. Janda stated that mail was going to her old address in Manitowoc County and is being forwarded to her current address at 853 Midway Road, Town of Menasha. Janda stated that even though the letters were not threatening or harassing, she did not want anything to do with Avery. Janda was advised to write Avery a letter stating that she wanted no more contact with him. The incident report was written by Officer Diedrich.
