01-17-2006 Case 05-1776 (Investigative Report)

On December 15, 2005 Sr. Electronics Technician Larry Flessert received a VHS tape (PT # C5069) from Special Agent Jim Sieler. The tape was from the security system at Menards, Manitowoc, and recorded on November 3, 2005. SA Sieler asked that a portion of the tape depicting the check out area be isolated and preserved. Technician Flessert locked the tape into the safe file in room 532 of Madison headquarters.

On January 19, 2005 Technician Flessert digitized the video clip pointed out by SA Sieler and placed it in a file on the hard drive of the AV lab computer. The file was then de-multiplexed using the StarWitness system. The resulting clip was then transferred to VHS tape.

On January 17, 2006 Technician Flessert returned the original VHS tape (PT # C5069) to SA Sieler. At that time SA Sieler requested four copies of the video clip previously processed be placed on DVD. Technician Flessert did so, and turned them over to SA Sieler the same day
