On Monday, January 9, 2006, S/A Thomas J. Fassbender received from S/A Joseph Kapitany evidence described as a Maxell VHS videotape T-120, designated under Property Receipt No. D-2602-1. S/A Kapitany removed said videotape from the Appleton DCI evidence room and transferred it to S/A Fassbender, per S/A Fassbender's request. The videotape contained a recording of the in-custody interview of Steven Avery on 11/09/2005.
