On Thursday, January 19, 2006, Investigator Mark Wiegert, of the Calumet County Sheriff's Department received a fax from the FBI, DNA Analysis Unit. The fax was a laboratory report from the FBI and pertained to charred remains that had been previously sent to the FBI for potential mitochondrial DNA analysis. It was reported that mitochondrial DNA sequences were obtained from the charred remains as well as the buccal swab from Karen Halbach, Teresa Halbach's mother. It was reported that the sequences obtained from those items were the same, with the exception of position "320". It was reported that due to the closely related sequences obtained from the specimens, Teresa Halbach cannot be excluded as the source of the charred remains.
