On Wednesday, February 1, 2006, at 4:24 p.m., S/A Thomas J. Fassbender telephoned George D. Dessart, 324 Mill St., in Reedsville, WI, 920-754-4769. Dessart's name and address had been provided to S/A Fassbender by scene security personnel at the Avery Salvage Yard. Personnel securing the scene had obtained Dessart's name as a result of him driving through or into the area. It was indicated that Dessart was a Ferrellgas delivery person. Upon contacting Dessart, S/A Fassbender explained that he was doing follow-up investigative work on the Teresa Halbach homicide and that he had received Dessart's name as noted above.

Dessart confirmed that he does deliver for Ferrellgas. Dessart advised, however, that he was not over in the area of the Avery Salvage Yard other than the day he provided his information to the officers. Dessart advised prior to that day, he had not been in that area for at least three to four weeks.

Dessart advised that he fills up the bulk for the delivery guys who deliver to the individual customers.

The interview was concluded at 4:30.
