At the request of DCI Special Agent Thomas Fassbender, Sr Electronics Technician Larry Flessert, processed, for increased clarity, the audio track of VHS tape D2602. Technician Flessert first copied the contents of the video track of the original tape in its entirety to the AV lab main computer using Pinnacle 10 software. Technician Flessert then copied the contents of the audio track of the original tape in its entirety to the SES computer. The copy if the audio track was processed in the SES computer using the SES software. After this was completed, Technician Flessert took the processed copy of the audio track from the SES computer and placed it on a DVD-R disk. This content was merged with the copy of the video track in the AV lab main computer. Using Pinnacle 10 software Technician Flessert synchronized the video and audio tracks. These synchronized tracks were then copied to a DVD-R disk using a JVC DR-M100 DVD recorder.

Per Agent Fassbender's request, four copies of this disk were produced. Technician Flessert then locked both the original VHS tape and the DVD copies into the locked file in room 532 of DCI Headquarters. Technician Flessert will contact Agent Fassbender on Monday February 13, 2006 to arrange return of the aforementioned materials to him.
