On Wednesday, February 8, 2006, at 9:52 a.m., S/A Thomas J. Fassbender received a telephone call from Bill Leurquin. S/A Fassbender had previously attempted to contact Leurquin at his telephone 920-553-7399. S/A Fassbender previously interviewed Leurquin's brother, John Leurquin.
