Pursuant to a request made by Calumet County Sheriff's Detective Mark Wiegert, S/A James C. Holmes met with Dr. Leslie Eisenberg at the Dane County Morgue on Wednesday, 02/15/2006 at approximately 8:30 a.m. to pick up cranial bone evidence to transfer to the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory for examination. Dr. Eisenberg provided S/A Holmes with two plastic bags containing evidentiary items for transfer to the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory. Both plastic bags were sealed with evidence tape.
