On Thursday, December 21, 2006, S/A Thomas J. Fassbender and Sergeant Bill Tyson, of the Calumet County Sheriff's Department interviewed Marge Franzen, a contracted employee with the Manitowoc County Clerk of Courts office. The interview took place in the Clerk of Courts office. Franzen provided the following information:

Franzen advised although she is a contracted employee, paid through Jenny Engstrom, she does work full-time hours. She advised she enters citations, filings, payments, and works the counter. She advised she has been with the Clerk of Courts office in Manitowoc County 7 years, in October.

Franzen advised that she does not know either Lieutenant Jim Lenk, or Sergeant Andy Colburn, from the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department.

Franzen advised that no one from the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department has ever asked her about the location of the Steven Avery Sexual Assault file, under Case No: 85-FE-118.

Franzen provided no further information and the interview was concluded.
