## Wisconsin Division of Criminal Investigation Case Report Case/Report Number: 05-1776/320

On Thursday, December 21, 2006, S/A Thomas J. Fassbender and Sergeant Bill Tyson, of the Calumet County Sheriff's Department interviewed Marge Badini, a Deputy Clerk for the Manitowoc County Clerk of Courts office. The interview took place in the Manitowoc County Clerk of Courts office. Badini provided the following information:

Badini advised she works Small Claims. She advised she has been with the Clerk of Courts office in Manitowoc County for 15 years.

Badini advised that she does not know Lieutenant Jim Lenk, of the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department, but may recognize him. She advised to her memory, she has never seen him in the Clerk of Courts office area, but stated she did not know who he is.

Badini advised she does know Sergeant Andy Colburn, of the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department and does not believe she has ever seen him in the Clerk of Courts office area.
