On Thursday, December 28, 2006, S/A Thomas J. Fassbender received a telephone call from Teresa Shebesta, a Deputy Clerk with the Manitowoc County Clerk of Courts office. Shebesta had been asked to telephone S/A Fassbender by the Manitowoc County Clerk of Courts, Lynn Zigmunt. Shebesta provided the following information:

Shebesta advised that she works in Juvenile. She advised she has been with the Clerk of Courts office, in Manitowoc County for 24½ years.

Shebesta advised that she knows who Lieutenant James Lenk, of the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department is. She advised that Lieutenant Lenk used to bailiff years ago, before he was on the road. She advised this was probably 15 to 20 years ago. Shebesta advised she does not recall ever seeing him in the Clerk of Courts office area. She commented that she has occasionally seen him out in the hall waiting to go into court.

Shebesta advised she was familiar with Sergeant Andy Colburn, of the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department, from Colburn running for sheriff. She advised she has never seen him in the courthouse and has never seen him by the Clerk of Courts office. Shebesta commented that Lieutenant Lenk and Sergeant Colburn do not come back into the Clerk of Courts office area, and that the court officers do.

Shebesta advised that no one from the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Department has ever asked her about the location of the Steven Avery Sexual Assault file, under Case No: 85-FE-118. She stated that she wouldn't even know where to find it herself.

Shebesta provided no further information and the interview was concluded.
