After meeting with Sgt Roof and Officer Holtzclaw at the Oklahoma County Jail, I returned to the incident location, 609 NW 121st, in an attempt to locate any witnesses to this use of force. After knocking at the door I met with WI-Gray. WI told me that she is AR's cousin. WI told me that there were no other adults present at this location at this time. I asked WI if she saw any interactions between the officers and her cousin. WI told me that no one at the house saw AR's actual arrest as it occurred around the corner on Chisholm Village Dr. She stated that AR was "messin'" with her mother's current husband. She stated that this became so bad that family members eventually called the police to intervene. Prior to the police arriving however, AR walked away from the residence. WI did say that after AR was in custody the officers (Roof and Holtzclaw), transported AR back to the house. WI told me that the police car was parked directly across the street from the house and AR was in the back seat. WI observed AR to break out the driver's side rear window. WI thought that AR used her head to break the window. After the window was broken she observed the two officers removed AR from the back seat of the scout car and place her on the ground. She said that one of the officers then went to the trunk of the car and removed some type of restraints. WI continued to watch as the officer applied the restraints on AR. WI stated that AR was screaming during this procedure. I asked the WI if she observed any type of improper actions by the officers. I specifically asked her if she observed them to punch or kick at her cousin. She stated that nothing like that happened and that the officers acted professional.

While reviewing the CAD comments on this call, I noticed some comments that had been added that appeared to come from a passerby who observed the actions of the officers. Her phone number was attached to these comments so I called her number and eventually was able to make contact with WI-Wilson.

I explained to WI that I was conducting an investigation in reference to the actions of the arresting officers and asked her if she would answer a few questions about what she observed. WI agreed.

WI stated that she was driving southbound on Chisholm Village Dr when she observed AR and a police officer on the east side of this street. This officer was later identified as Sgt Roof. WI went on to say that the AR was handcuffed and was on her knees in front of the officer. WI told me that she could tell that the officer was saying something to the AR; and that the AR was yelling back at the officer. WI stated that based on the way AR was moving her body, WI believed that the AR was saying "something hateful." At this time WI observed as the officer slapped the AR on the left side of her face. WI told me that this slap caused the AR to fall back down to the ground. After the AR was back down on the ground the WI told me that the officer rolled her over onto her stomach and put his knee in her back. I asked WI if she was sure that the officer slapped the AR and that he was not forcing her back to the ground. To this WI told me that she thought that the officer had slapped the female and that it did not appear to be a push or shove.

Prior to ending the conversation WI asked for, and was given my name and badge number.

I responded to 609 NW 121st to assist Sgt Roof and Officer Holtzclaw with a use of force in which they had just been involved. Before I was able to arrive at the scene, these officers were forced to transport AR-Washington to the Oklahoma County Jail. They made this decision to transport her immediately because of her aggressive and assaultive behavior. While in route to the jail they were forced to stop their scout car twice on the Broadway Extension so that they could re-secure AR in her restraints. I followed these officers as they drove to the jail with AR.

Once we all arrived at the jail facility several detention officers were required to remove AR from the scout car and move her inside the building. I waited for several minutes after she had been taken inside before I attempted to speak to her.

I then made contact with AR as she was seated inside the receiving area. At this time she still wore the protective "Spit Sock." I began and attempted to obtain her demographical information. It was virtually impossible to obtain any information whatsoever from AR at this time. After about 10 minutes of talking to her I was only able to get her name, date of birth, and address. While I tried to speak to her she would yell at the detention officers. Eventually I moved her away from the detention officers and took her into the intoxilyzer room. After she was moved she calmed down for several minutes and I was able to gather some information from her. It should be noted that while speaking to AR I detected the odor of burnt marijuana on her breath; I was also able to smell the odor of PCP.

I explained to her that I was here to investigate the actions of the arresting officers. I then asked her to explain what happened tonight when she was arrested. Instead of responding she stared at me. After a minute of silence I asked her to tell me why she ran from the officers. She responded and stated that, "I ran from them and they pushed me to the ground." I asked her to tell me why she ran away from the officers. To this she replied, "I ran cuz of my son and they said I had drugs." I then tried to explain to her that her family members called the police because they were concerned for her well being, and were afraid that she was using drugs. As soon as I mentioned her family she became very agitated again and told me that her mother's husband said he wanted to "fuck me in my ass." She then went on a verbal rampage for several minutes about her mother's husband.

I then asked her if she had been injured. Through her yelling and screaming I did understand that she was upset that an officer had placed his knee in her back. She also mentioned that she had been punched in her face. I tried to ask her where she had been struck and she continually told me to "look at my face, look at my face!" I did look at her face, along with the Oklahoma County nurse. We were unable to locate any injury on her face. The only visible injury I found on her entire body was a small abrasion on her left elbow.

Her behavior during this interview can best be described as chaotic. For the most part she would yell at and threaten the detention staff and at other times she would cry. I asked her about any drug use and she denied using any today.

On 05-12-12 at 1858 hours Sgt Roof and his recruit, Officer Holtzclaw, responded to 609 NW 121st in reference to a disturbance call. The comments on this call stated that yelling could be heard in the background. In addition, the dispatcher could hear someone stating that there was a person at this location with warrants, and that a female at this location was throwing bottles.

Upon their arrival the officer encounter what they believed to be some type of family cook out in the front yard of this residence. At this time the officers made contact with the reporting party, Carmelliu Harwell. The RP told the officers that her daughter, who was later identified as AR-Washington, had drugs on her person, and had outstanding warrants for her arrest. The RP also expressed concern that her daughter was out of control and needed help. They also learned that AR had fled the scene on foot, just prior to their arrival.

Together the two officers began to check the area for AR. They located AR as she was walking near the intersection of NW 121st/Chisholm Village Dr. Officer Holtzclaw attempted to initiate contact with AR by stating, "Excuse me mam, can I talk to you please?" AR took off running away from the officers at this point. Officer Holtzclaw pursued AR on foot and was followed by Sgt Roof. During the foot chase Officer Holtzclaw observed AR to throw a clear plastic baggy over a stockade fence. Officer Holtzclaw was able to close the distance with AR. As soon as he got close to her, AR began "flailing and swinging" her arms toward officer Holtzclaw. Officer Holtzclaw gave her verbal commands to "stop resisting." Officer Holtzclaw received a laceration on his right forearm as a result of being scratched by AR at this time. After being assaulted by AR, Officer Holtzclaw performed a front leg sweep and took AR to the ground. The specific arrest location was on Chisholm Village Dr between NW 121st and NW 121st Terrace on the east side of the street. AR landed in the grass as she was taken down by Officer Holtzclaw. Once on the ground Officer Holtzclaw gave her verbal commands to roll over onto her stomach. He noted in his report that when issued these verbal commands, AR yelled "No!" and continued to resist his arrest efforts by attempting to pull her hand away. Officer Holtzclaw then placed AR's right arm in an academy taught arm lock and was able to gain some compliance. After placing AR in the arm lock she rolled over onto her stomach. Once she was on her stomach Officer Holtzclaw mounted her back and he was able to apply handcuffs. Sgt Roof arrived at this location after AR had been handcuffed.

Officer Holtzclaw advised Sgt Roof that AR had thrown an object over a nearby fence and that he wanted to go look for what was thrown. Sgt Roof then assumed the position of control on AR's back while Officer Holtzclaw went to look for what had been thrown. At this time AR was still yelling profanities and was flailing around on the ground. Sgt Roof stated that when he switched places with Officer Holtzclaw he placed his knees next to her side and placed his hands on her handcuffs. While he was holding onto the handcuffs, AR was able to reach around and use her fingernails to scratch Sgt Roof's hands. He received several scratches on his left hand and disengaged from AR to try to prevent further injury. As soon as he disengaged AR quickly tried to twist her

body and get up on her knees. Sgt Roof gave AR additional verbal commands, telling her to stay on the ground. AR refused to follow these verbal commands and was able to make it to her knees and attempt to stand up. While he was still on his knees, nearly facing AR, he used both of his hands and pushed both of AR's shoulders. This push caused AR to fall backwards and fall back to the ground on her back. Sgt Roof then rolled her back over onto her stomach and placed both knees across her back to stabilize and control her movements.

Officer Holtzclaw was unable to locate what AR had thrown and he re-joined Sgt Roof. Together these officers picked AR up to her feet and began to escort her back to their scout car. Sgt Roof held AR by her right arm during this escort and Officer Holtzclaw had the left side. As they walked back to the scout car AR continued trying to pull away from the officers. Sgt Roof also noted that while they were walking back AR unsnapped his OC case and grabbed at his keys on his duty belt. AR was then seated in the back seat of their scout car.

Officer Holtzclaw then attempted to gain more information from AR's family while Sgt Roof remained at the scout car and monitored AR. While Officer Holtzclaw was outside the vehicle, Sgt Roof observed as AR lay down and began to kick repeatedly at the driver's side rear door window. This action knocked the window out of place. Sgt Roof exited the vehicle and opened the back door to prevent her from damaging the window any further. As Sgt Roof opened the door AR began to tell him that she wanted to see her son and that she needed to be let go. Sgt Roof noted that AR calmed down somewhat while the back door was open. At this time Sgt Roof spoke to AR, asking her to calm down and to not try to kick at the window any more. Sgt Roof then rolled the window down, and rolled it back up, which re-aligned the window with the door frame. He then closed the back door and went to assist Officer Holtzclaw in interviewing the RP. Sgt Roof considered utilizing the maximal restraint system (legs only) at this time, but felt that AR had calmed down enough that this system was not warranted at this time.

AR then began kicking on the window again; this time she kicked it with enough force that the glass actually flew out of the door and fell onto the ground and shattered. AR then stuck her head out of the window opening and began yelling at her family.

Together the officers then removed AR from the back seat and placed her on the ground, on her stomach. Officer A Moore had also just arrived at the scene and observed AR to kick out the rear window. While Officer Holtzclaw secured AR on the ground, Sgt Roof went to his trunk and obtained the maximal restraint system. Initially the leg restraints were only used; these were secured around her legs, and the loose end was closed in the door. Officer Moore and Officer Holtzclaw were able to pick AR up off the ground and place in back in the scout car.

Because of her violent and aggressive behavior, the officers quickly finished their interview at the scene and immediately began to transport AR to the Oklahoma County Jail.

It should be noted that I had been made aware of this incident, and was in route to their location, but was coming from SE 29th street. I was unable to arrive at the scene before it became necessary to transport AR.

While Officer Holtzclaw and Sgt Roof transported AR, her violent and erratic behavior continued. She continually yelled at the officers and threatened to kill them. On at least one occasion she banged her head against the plexi-glass partition in the scout car. Despite having her legs restrained she was able to move into a sitting position. After banging her head she then began to spit through the perforated section of the scout car cage. Her saliva travelled through the perforated section and struck Sgt Roof on his back and neck. Some of her saliva struck the dashboard of the vehicle. After being assaulted with her bodily fluid the officers stopped their scout car as they travelled southbound on the Broadway Extension in the area of Hefner Road. Once they had stopped they retrieved the sit belt and removed AR from the scout car once again. At this time Officers Moore, Holtzclaw and Sgt Roof applied the sit belt to AR. The leg restraints were then secured to the sit belt and not to her handcuffs. These officers then placed her back into the vehicle and continued to the jail. After a short time, AR was able once again to assume somewhat of a sitting position and again began to spit through the perforated partition. Once again they stopped and pulled over at the Broadway Extension and I-44. I was able to arrive at their location at this time and provided the officers with a "Spit Sock." Sgt Roof then placed this "Spit Sock" on AR's head. I then opened the rear, driver's side door of his car and attempted to speak to AR in an attempt to calm her down. While I was speaking to her I adjusted the "Spit Sock" in an attempt to distract her while Sgt Roof attempted to use the vehicle seat belt to further restrain her so that she would be unable to assume a sitting position. Specifically, Sgt Roof used the passenger side rear seat belt and placed it around her waist area to secure her in a prone position in the back seat.

From this point there was no additional force used by OCPD. They were able to arrive at the jail and the detention staff removed AR from the scout car and escorted her inside. I can say that her behavior was aggressive, and verbally abusive. She would not cooperate with the jail staff and it took six jail employees to remove her from the car and get her inside. As part of this investigation I did the best I could to interview AR. I waited for several minutes after she had been inside before I attempted to speak to her. During my interview I found that she was extremely upset with the detention staff. Initially she was so angry and distracted by their mere presence, I moved her into the Intoxilyzer Room. This change in location seemed to calm her down for a few minutes. At this time I was able to smell the odor of burnt marijuana coming from her breath; I also smelled the unmistakable odor of PCP. During this interview I learned that while she was at the family cookout, she had some type of a problem with her mother's current husband. The disturbance between AR and her mother's husband prompted other family members to call the police. During our discussion she admitted to running from the police and she told me that one of them (Officer Holtzclaw) pushed her to the ground. She also claimed that she had been struck in the face by one of the officers. I tried to get more specific information from her about this. When I asked where she had been struck she started yelling at me and telling me to look at her face. I looked, but was unable to find any visible injuries. In an attempt to be sure I had not missed visualizing an injury the nurse on duty assisted me. The county nurse removed her hair extensions. He also examined her face looking for

injuries. Together we found none. There was no blood on her face or in her mouth. I did find a small abrasion on her left elbow. I took several photographs of AR at this time. Photographs of Sgt Roof's scout car were also taken. These photographs documented the damage to the window; I was also able to locate and photograph copious amounts of saliva on the perforated partition. After speaking to AR, I returned to 609 NW 121st in an attempt to interview anyone who may have seen the interaction between the officers and AR. When I returned to this location the only adult present was WI-Gray. She told me that she is AR's cousin. WI-Gray was present at the house when the incident occurred. WI-Gray told me that the actual arrest occurred around the corner from the family residence and that she did not see it. WI-Gray observed as AR broke out the window of the scout car. She told me that she thought AR had used her head to break out the window. She was present when Officer Holtzclaw and Sgt Roof removed AR from the back seat and applied the legs restraints. I asked WI-Gray if she had observed any actions by the involved officers that she felt was improper. She told me that she saw nothing like that and felt that the officers acted in a professional manner.

While reviewing the CAD call I initially missed several comments that had been added. I saw that there was another 911 caller. From the comments on the call it appeared that this caller was a passer-by and witnessed part of the arrest of AR. The comments indicated that she witnessed one of the officers slap AR. There was a phone number along with these comments so I called the number. After several attempts I was able to make contact with WI-Wilson. WI-Wilson confirmed that she was the 911 caller and was driving by the location at the time of the arrest. WI-Wilson told me that she was driving southbound on Chisholm Village Dr. when she observed AR and an officer on the east side of this street. The officer has been identified as Sgt Roof. WI-Wilson told me that AR was handcuffed and was on her knees in front of Sgt Roof. WI-Wilson said that it was clear that Sgt Roof was saying something to the AR and that the AR was saying something back to the officer. WI-Wilson told me that she could tell the AR was saying "something hateful" by the way the AR's body was moving. WI-Wilson stated that as she drove by she observed the officer to slap the AR on the left side of her face. She stated that this slap caused the AR to fall back down to the ground. After the AR fell down to the ground she stated that Sgt Roof rolled her over onto her stomach and put his knee in her back. I asked WI-Wilson if she was sure that the officer had slapped the AR, and that he was not pushing her back down onto the ground. WI-Wilson then told me that she really felt that the officer had slapped the AR and that it did not appear to be a push or a shove. While speaking to WI-Wilson I really got the impression that she did not trust me with what I would do with this information. I explained to her that a use of force occurred during this arrest; and that it was my responsibility to investigate the actions of the involved officers. I read my notes back to her and asked her if they accurately reflected what she had just told me. She told me that my notes were accurate. I then assured her that my report would include her observations and that it would be forwarded up my chain of command. Prior to ending the conversation with WI-Wilson she was provided with my name and badge number.

As part of this investigation I spoke to Officer Holtzclaw and Sgt Roof separately about WI-Wilson's observations. I asked Sgt Roof specifically if he had slapped AR as she tried to get back to her feet. Sgt Roof denied slapping AR. He stated that he used both of his hands and pushed AR's shoulders, forcing her back down to the ground. At the time that WI-Wilson observed this, Officer Holtzclaw was looking for contraband that AR threw during the foot chase. I specifically asked Officer Holtzclaw if he observed Officer Roof to slap AR. He stated that he saw nothing like this occur. I saw no evidence that AR had been struck on her face. Specifically the left side of her face was injury free, as was her entire body, except for a small abrasion on her left elbow. The on duty Oklahoma County nurse also examined AR with me while at the jail. He was also unable to locate any injury to AR's face. I reviewed AR's criminal history as well. She has several arrests documented with this Department. These arrests include Possession of CDS, Destruction of Property, and an Aggravated Assault and battery on Police in 2004. She has no Oklahoma Department of Corrections convictions.

The officer's use of force was reasonable and consistent with this Department's Use of Force Policy

At this point I received a small laceration across my right forearm trying to apprehend AR in a stress free style.

I proceeded to maneuver a takedown move. I grabbed AR's left arm while she was flailing and pulled her towards my direction. As AR's body continued to my direction I placed my right foot on the ground causing AR to trip over my right foot and lose balance. At this time I used AR's momentum and controlled her to the ground. I back mounted AR and placed her in handcuffs.

BODY OF REPORT:

ON 5/12/12 AT APPROXIMATELY 1904 HOURS, OFFICER HOLTZCLAW 1782 AND I RESPONDED TO 609 NW 121ST ST IN REFERENCE TO A TROUBLE UNKNOWN. THE CALL ADVISED THAT A FEMALE WAS CAUSING PROBLEMS AND THROWING BOTTLES AT PEOPLE.

UPON ARRIVAL, WE MADE CONTACT WITH RP WHO TOLD US THAT HER DAUGHTER (AR-WASHINGTON) WAS OUT OF CONTROL AND NEEDS HELP. RP SAID AR IS ON DRUGS, HAS THEM ON HER, AND HAS WARRANTS. RP STATED THAT AR WAS AROUND THE CORNER ON NW 121ST TE.

OFFICER HOLTZCLAW AND I ATTEMPTED TO FIND AR BY CANVASSING THE NEIGHBORHOOD IN THE DIRECTION RP STATED. AS OFFICER HOLTZCLAW ROUNDED THE CORNER TO NW 121ST TE, I HEARD HIM SAY "MA'AM CAN I TALK TO YOU" AND THEN HE TOOK OFF RUNNING. I CONTINUED IN OFFICER HOLTZCLAW'S DIRECTION AS HE ATTEMPTED TO CLOSE THE GAP ON AR AND TAKE HER INTO CUSTODY.

I FINALLY CAUGHT UP TO OFFICER HOLTZCLAW ON THE EASTSIDE OF THE ROAD ON CHISHOLM VILLAGE DR BETWEEN NW 121ST TE AND NW 121ST ST. OFFICER HOLTZCLAW HAD AR HANDCUFFED AND STABILIZING HER ON THE GROUND. AS I APPROACHED CLOSER, AR WAS YELLING PROFANITIES AND FLAILING AROUND. OFFICER HOLTZCLAW TOLD ME THAT HE BELIEVED AR THREW SOMETHING DOWN WHILE SHE WAS RUNNING. I WAS UNABLE TO LOCATE THE PROPERTY IN QUESTION AND REQUESTED OFFICER HOLTZCLAW TO TRADE PLACES WITH ME AND LOOK FOR WHAT AR THREW DOWN.

AR REMAINED ON THE GROUND ON HER STOMACH. I SWITCHED PLACES WITH OFFICER HOLTZCLAW AND CONTINUED TO RESTRAIN AR ON THE GROUND ON HER STOMACH. I PLACED MY KNEES NEXT HER SIDE AND HELD MY HANDS ON HER HANDCUFFS. WHILE MY HANDS WERE CLOSE TO AR'S HANDS, SHE CONTINUED TO FLAIL AROUND AND STARTED SCRATCHING AT ME. I SUSTAINED INJURY TO MY LEFT HAND ON THE BACKSIDE DUE TO AR'S SCRATCHING.

AT THAT POINT, I DISENGAGED FROM AR TO KEEP FROM SUSTAINING ANY OTHER INJURY. I RELEASED MY HANDS FROM AR AND STAYED NEXT TO HER SIDE. DUE TO RELEASING FROM AR, SHE QUICKLY TRIED TO TWIST AROUND AND GET UP ON HER KNEES. I REPEATEDLY TOLD AR TO STOP MOVING AROUND AND STAY ON THE GROUND. I TOLD AR TO STAY ON HER STOMACH AND TO NOT GET UP.

AR EVENTUALLY MADE HER WAY TO HER KNEES AND TRIED TO STAND UP. AT THIS POINT, AR WAS ON HER KNEES DIRECTLY FACING ME WHILE I WAS ON MY KNEES. IN ORDER TO AVOID SUSTAINING MORE INJURY AND KEEP AR FROM GETTING ALL THE WAY UP, I PUSHED AR DOWN, BACK ON THE GROUND. WHEN OFFICER HOLTZCLAW RESPONDED BACK, WE PICKED AR UP BY HER ARMS AND ESCORTED HER BACK TO THE PATROL CAR AT 609 NW 121ST ST. WHILE WALKING, AR CONTINUED TO YELL AND TRY TO PULL AWAY FROM ME. I ESCORTED AR BY GRABBING HER RIGHT ARM WITH MY LEFT HAND AND GRABBING HER RIGHT HAND WITH MY RIGHT HAND. I CONTINUED TO ESCORT AR AND DURING THE WALK, AR TRIED TO GRAB AT ITEMS ON MY GUN BELT. AR WAS ABLE TO UNSNAP MY OC HOLSTER AND PULL AT MY KEY CHAIN.

AFTER ARRIVING AT THE PATROL CAR, AR STARTED YELLING AT HER FAMILY MEMBERS AT 609 NW 121ST ST. AR KEPT SAYING GIVE ME MY SON AND HELP ME. OFFICER HOLTZCLAW AND I WERE SUCCESSFULLY ABLE TO PUT AR IN THE BACKSEAT OF THE PATROL CAR WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT.

OFFICER HOLTZCLAW ATTEMPTED TO GET MORE INFORMATION FROM RP WHILE I KEPT AR IN VIEW. AR KEPT YELLING THROUGH THE WINDOW ATTEMPTING TO INTERACT WITH HER FAMILY. I COULD ALSO SEE RP SHAKING HER HEAD AT AR REQUESTING WE GET HER SOME HELP.

AT THIS POINT, AR LAID DOWN IN THE SEAT AND KICKED AT THE BACK DRIVER SIDE WINDOW WITH BOTH FEET. AR KICKED AT THE WINDOW REPEATEDLY SLIGHTLY KNOCKING THE WINDOW OUT OF PLACE. PATROL CAR. I LIFTED AR UP ON HER LEFT SIDE AND SLID HER INTO THE PATROL CAR. I THEN WENT AROUND TO THE OTHER SIDE AND PULLED THE LEG RESTRAINT STRAP DOWN. I CLOSED THE BACK DOOR AND SECURED THE STRAP TO THE PATROL CAR. THIS RESTRAINT PROCEDURE WAS ABLE TO KEEP AR ON HER STOMACH LAID DOWN WHILE OFFICER HOLTZCLAW FINISHED WITH THE INVESTIGATION.

AFTER FINISHING, OFFICER HOLTZCLAW AND I TRANSPORTED AR TO THE OKLAHOMA COUNTY JAIL. DURING TRANSPORT, AR BEGAN TO TURN HER ATTENTION TO US AND YELL PROFANITIES. AR TOLD US THAT SHE WAS GOING TO KILL US AND WE WOULD PAY FOR WHAT WE DID. AR WAS THEN ABLE TO LEAN UP IN THE SEAT. AR MOVED AROUND BELLIGERENTLY AND AT ONE POINT STARTED BANGING HER HEAD ON THE PLEXI-GLASS BEHIND THE DRIVE SEAT. AR QUICKLY MOVED OVER TO THE PERFORATED CAGE DIVIDER WHICH PLACED HER HEAD APPROXIMATELY ONE FOOT AWAY FROM THE BACK OF MY HEAD WITH THE CAGE IN BETWEEN. AR YELLED PROFANITIES AT ME AND THEN SPIT IN MY DIRECTION. I COULD SEE THE SALIVA FLY ACROSS ON THE DASH. AS I LOOKED BACK, I COULD SEE SALIVA ON MY UNIFORM, ON THE SEAT, AND CAGE BEHIND ME.

AT THAT TIME, OFFICER HOLTZCLAW PULLED THE PATROL CAR OVER AROUND BROADWAY EXTENSION SB AT HEFNER RD. I RETRIEVED THE REST OF THE MAXIMUM RESTRAINTS. OFFICER HOLTZCLAW AND OFFICER MOORE 1690 HELD AR DOWN ON HER STOMACH IN THE BACK SEAT WHILE I APPLIED THE SIT-BELT. I WRAPPED THE SIT-BELT AROUND AR'S WASTE AND OFFICER MOORE ATTACHED THE LEG RESTRAINT TO THE SIT-BELT. OFFICER MOORE PUT THE SIT-BELT THROUGH THE D-RING AND AT NO POINT DID HE ATTACH THE MAXIMUM RESTRAINTS TO AR'S HANDCUFFS. I THEN ATTACHED THE LEG RESTRAINT STRAP BACK AROUND AR'S LEGS.

AR WAS PLACED ON HER STOMACH, AND WE WERE ABLE TO GO BACK EN ROUTE TO COUNTY. DURING TRANSPORT, AR CONTINUED TO YELL AND ACT EXCITED AND BELLIGERENT. EVENTUALLY, AR WAS ABLE TO TWIST AROUND AND SIT UP AGAIN NEXT TO THE CAGE DIVIDER. AR YELLED AT ME AND THEN SPIT AGAIN MY DIRECTION. I OBSERVED MORE SALIVA HIT THE DASH. I LOOKED BACK AND OBSERVED MORE SALIVA ON MY UNIFORM, SEAT , AND THE CAGE.

AT THIS POINT, OFFICER HOLTZCLAW PULLED THE VEHICLE OVER ON BROADWAY EXTENSION SB AT I-44. I WAS ABLE TO OPEN THE DOOR AND PUSH AR BACK DOWN ON THE BACKSEAT ON HER STOMACH. LT CONIGLIONE 1198 GAVE ME A SPIT MASK WHICH I PLACED AROUND AR'S HEAD. DUE TO NOT HAVING ANYMORE RESTRAINTS, I BUCKLED THE BACK PASSENGER SIDE SHOULDER BELT AROUND AR IN AN EFFORT TO KEEP HER LAYING FLAT AND NOT BEING ABLE TO GET UP.

ONCE AGAIN, WE WENT BACK EN ROUTE TO COUNTY. DURING THE TRANSPORT, AR WAS NOT ABLE TO GET HER SELF UP BUT SHE CONTINUED TO YELL AND SPEAK PROFANITIES AT US. AR CONTINUED TO MAKE RACIAL COMMENTS AND THREATEN TO KILL US AND OUR FAMILIES. AR STATED THAT SHE WAS GOING TO "FUCK US IN THE ASS" AND "HOPES MY SON BITES MY DICK OFF." AR CONTINUED WITH HER BELLIGERENT DEMEANOR AND NEVER CALMED DOWN DURING THE TRANSPORT.

AT COUNTY, THE DETENTION OFFICERS TOOK CUSTODY OF AR AND ESCORTED HER INSIDE. WHILE OUTSIDE OF THE PATROL CAR, I OBSERVED THE BACK SIDE OF MY LEFT HAND TO HAVE SEVERAL SCRATCH MARKS. I ALSO OBSERVED MY RIGHT ELBOW TO HAVE SKIN ABRASIONS AND REDNESS TO THE AREA. I OBSERVED THE CAGE DIVIDER TO HAVE SALIVA
