Detective Sneed interviewed Lieutenant Gamille Hardin. stated she had told Hardin about the rape incidents. During her interview with Sneed, Hardin stated she had not heard about the rape incidents until November 7, 2013. (The date went to house)	
and filed for a VPO against the other. Cleveland County on November 8, 2013. On November 13, 2013, Cleveland County Judge Jequita Napoli dismissed the VPO. filed for a VPO against in Oklahoma County on November 14, 2013. An emergency order of protection was denied in Oklahoma County court by Judge Don Andrews on November 14, 3013. The VPO was dismissed in Oklahoma County Court by Judge Don Andrews on January 9, 2014.	
On November 15, 2013, Lieutenant made allegations of the criminal case being bias and questioned how the case was being investigated. As a result the criminal case was reassigned to the Office of Professional Standards to conduct the investigation.	
During Lieutenant Oster's investigation she attempted to interview the brother of Wayne Lt. Stated she had told her brother everything about the alleged rape incidents. Wayne would not respond to any correspondence from Lt. Oster. Lt. Oster requested Lt. to have her brother call Lt. Oster. Wayne still would not make contact with Lt. Oster.	
Criminal Investigation	
On December 5, 2013, Lieutenant S. Oster was assigned to conduct a criminal investigation into the allegation Sgt. appearance and Lieutenant on two occasions.	

On January 2, 2014, the criminal case was presented to Oklahoma County Assistant District Attorney Scott Rowland. After reviewing the facts of the case Rowland declined to file charges based on 1) insufficient evidence to prove beyond a reasonable doubt, 2) disclosure was delayed two to three months and 3) the only evidence is the victim's statement.

Administrative Investigation

On January 10, 2014, Chief Citty was briefed on the findings of the criminal investigation and the decision not to file charges by the Oklahoma County District Attorney's office. No administrative investigation was requested.
