2 A He would just give me updates on where they  
3 were at through their investigation, whether or not they  
4 had located her yet, and then when they did.

5 Q Was May 27th, 2014, was that the first time you  
6 talked to Capt. Bacy about Terri Morris?

7 A The incident occurred on the 4th. It was on  
8 Monday. It was a holiday weekend. It was on the Monday  
9 of the last day of the holiday weekend.

10 Q If I represent to you that Ms. Morris made her  
11 allegations on May 24, 2014, does that sound correct to  
12 you?

13 A Yes.

14 Q And that was a Friday.

15 A Okay.

16 MR. SMITH: Object to the form. It  
17 wasn't.

18 THE WITNESS: It was a Saturday, I  
19 believe.

20 Q (By Mr. Solomon-Simmons) Well, yeah, Saturday  
21 morning, like 2:00 in the morning, that's correct.

23 Q And so the first time you spoke to Capt. Bacy  
24 about the incident that occurred with Terri Morris, when  
25 she made her allegations, was that next Monday?

1 A That is correct.

2 Q And is it also the chief who decides when a  
3 case would be investigated been internal affairs?

4 A Yes.

5 Q Okay.

6 A But the chief also decides whether or not it's  
7 going to be worked by the Investigations Bureau or out  
8 of the Office of the Chief, which is where the Office of  
9 Professional Standards is assigned.

10 Q So the fact that it was being investigated by  
11 the sex crimes Unit, that was in lieu of being  
12 investigated by Professional Standards. Is that what  
13 you're saying?

14 A That's correct. Chief Kuhlman, I'm sure,  
15 briefed the chief at some point and it was decided that  
16 Investigations would continue the investigation beyond  
17 just the preliminary instead of it being transferred to  
18 Internal Affairs.

19 Q So the Internal Affairs investigation would  
20 only kick in or start once the criminal investigation  
21 was over?

22 A Under -- it depends on the situation. But  
23 under this particular case, because it was being  
24 investigated out of Investigations, then, yes, once --  
25 once it was either declined or adjudicated then the
